6. The people who established the Mauryan Empire entered India via the Khyber Pass, a passage through the Hindu Kush mountains.
7. Science, technology, math (including today's Arabic numbers), and art were highly developed in India's Gupta Empire, beginning in about A.D. 320.
8. From the late 1700s, the British raj, their Indian empire, dominated all of India.
9. In the first half of the twentieth century, Mohandas K. Gandhi led India's fight for independence from Britain.
10. After independence in 1947, many thousands of India's Muslims left to live in Pakistan.
11. After East Pakistan broke away from its western counterpart, it took the name Bangladesh.
12. Today, India is the world's largest democracy.
13. Instability led to a military takeover in Pakistan in 1999.
14. The countries of Bhutan and Nepal are ruled by traditional monarchies.
