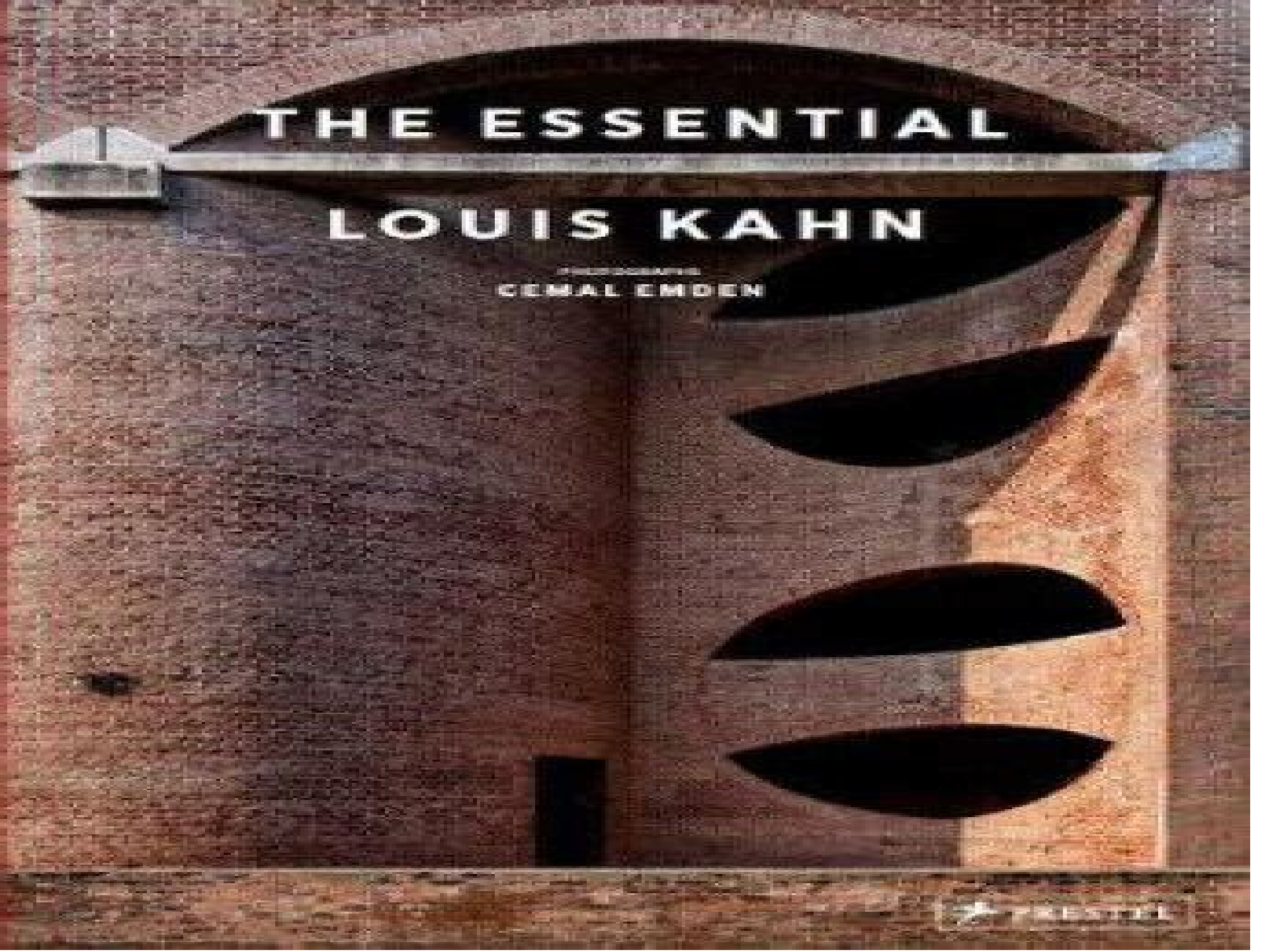

The art museum has become a prestige commission for contemporary architects and for several decades reference has been made to a museum building boom. Among these new museums, those of Louis Kahn are especially admired.
