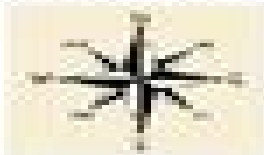


Geography Vocabulary Study Guide

globe	A 3-dimensional representation of the Earth. A globe is a sphere.										
cartography	The art and science of making maps.										
cartographer	A person that makes maps.										
map	A map is a flat (2-dimensional) graphic (pictured) representation of the Earth's surface, showing how things are related to each other by distance, direction, and size. Maps are 2-dimensional representations of a 3-dimensional world. There are many different types of maps that have different uses.										
title	The title of a map tells you what region or place the map represents.										
key (legend)	Explains what the symbols and colors on the map represent.										
symbols	Picture represents a feature or object. Example: blue wavy lines may represent a lake.										
scale	The relationship between the distance on the map and the actual distance on the Earth's surface. Example: 1 inch on the map may equal 1 mile on the Earth's surface.										
compass	Navigation instrument that uses the Earth's magnetic field to determine direction.

latitude	Imaginary horizontal lines (parallel) on a grid map.										
longitude	Imaginary vertical lines (not parallel) on a grid map.										
hemisphere	A hemisphere is half the Earth's surface.										
equator	Imaginary latitude line that divides the earth into Northern and Southern Hemispheres (0 degree latitude).										
Prime Meridian	Imaginary longitude line that divides the earth into Eastern and Western Hemispheres (0 degree longitude). The prime meridian runs through the Royal Greenwich Observatory in Greenwich, England (the location was established in 1884 by international agreement).										
map grid	Latitude and longitude lines form an imaginary grid over the Earth's surface. By combining longitude and latitude measurements, any location on earth can be determined.
