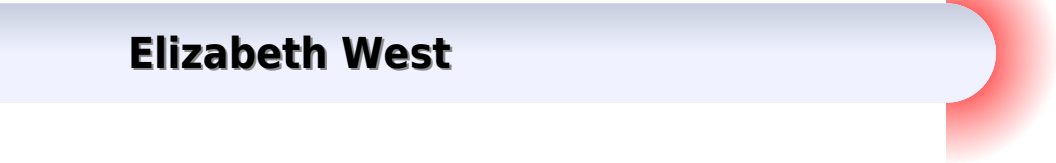

The WPA Guide to New Mexico certainly shows how this Southwest state earned its nickname the Colorful State The blended influence of Native American Spanish and Anglo American cultures account for the Land of Enchantment s distinct flavor thoroughly captured in the guide s stunning photography as well as in its many essays on art folklore and language **The Lore of New Mexico** Marta Weigle,Peter White,2003 This award winning text on New Mexico folklore traditions is now available in a shorter edition **Indian Placenames in America** Sandy Nestor,2015-05-07 The American Indians have lost much of their land over the years but their legacy is evident in the many places around the United States that have Indian names Countless placenames have however been corrupted over time and numerous placenames have similar spellings but different meanings This reference work is a reprint in one combined volume of the two volume set published by McFarland in 2003 and 2005 Volume One covers the name origins and histories of cities towns and villages in the United States that have Indian names It is arranged alphabetically by state then alphabetically by city town or village name Additional data include population figures and county names Probable Indian placenames with no certain origin also receive entries and as much history as possible is provided about those locations Volume Two covers more than 1400 rivers lakes mountains and other natural features in the United States with Indian names It is arranged by state and then alphabetically by natural feature Counties are provided for most entries with multiple counties listed for some entries where appropriate In addition to name origins and meanings geophysical data such as the heights of mountains and lengths of waterways are indicated A Splendid Savage Steve Kemper,2016-01-21 Rich detailed and pitch perfect with the witty and wonderful skipping off every page Maxwell Carter Wall Street Journal Frederick Russell Burnham s 1861 1947 amazing story resembles a newsreel fused with a Saturday matinee thriller One of the few people who could turn his garrulous friend Theodore Roosevelt into a listener Burnham was once world famous as the American scout His expertise in woodcraft learned from frontiersmen and Indians helped inspire another friend Robert Baden Powell to found the Boy Scouts His adventures encompassed Apache wars and range feuds booms and busts in mining camps around the globe explorations in remote regions of Africa and death defying military feats that brought him renown and high honors His skills led to his unusual appointment as an American to be Chief of Scouts for the British during the Boer War where his daring exploits earned him the Distinguished Service Order from King Edward VII After a lifetime pursuing golden prospects from the deserts of Mexico and Africa to the tundra of the Klondike Burnham found wealth in his sixties near his childhood home in southern California Other men of his era had a few such adventures but Burnham had them all His friend H Rider Haggard author of many best selling exotic tales remarked In real life he is more interesting than any of my heroes of romance Among other well known individuals who figure in Burnham s story are Cecil Rhodes and William Howard Taft as well as some of the wealthiest men of the day including John Hays Hammond E H Harriman Henry Payne Whitney and the Guggenheim brothers Failure and tragedy streaked his life as well but he was endlessly willing to set off into the unknown where the future felt up for grabs and values worth dying for were at

stake Steve Kemper brings a quintessential American story to vivid life in this gripping biography *Hispano Folklife of New Mexico* Lorin W. Brown, Charles L. Briggs, Marta Weigle, 1978 For generations the remote villages of northern New Mexico lay virtually undisturbed quietly passing through the predictable cycles of an agrarian society and preserving a colonial Hispanic culture unique to the United States Fortunately many of the old traditions were preserved through the work of Lorin W Brown who was born and raised in New Mexico In the late 1930s he was employed by the New Mexico Federal Writers Project to document the folklife of Hispanic northern New Mexico Brown produced almost 200 manuscripts all based on his interviews with many elderly residents of Cordova Truchas and other isolated communities thus preserving an oral history stretching back to the late 18th century Amazon *Frontier Stories* Ann Lacy, Anne Valley-Fox, 2010-02-15 Between 1850 and 1912 the year New Mexico was granted statehood the Territory of New Mexico was a wild and dangerous place Homesteaders cowboys ranchers sheepherders buffalo hunters prospectors treasure hunters and railroad men pushing the borders of the western frontier met with resistance from man and animal alike Native Americans who had lived on the land defending their boundaries and way of life for centuries reacted to the wave of outsiders in various ways The agrarian Pueblo peoples along the Rio Grande largely kept to themselves Apache Navajo and Ute tribes sometimes attempted to co exist with the newcomers but most often they fought against encroachment Anglo and Mexican outlaws ran roughshod across the frontier and there was no shortage of bears wolves mountain lions blizzards and bad water to unsettle the newcomers This collection of frontier stories vividly illustrates the range of struggles triumphs and catastrophes faced by settlers who hoped to tame the land and inhabitants of Territorial New Mexico Between 1936 and 1940 field workers in the Federal Writers Project a branch of the government funded Works Progress Administration or WPA later called Work Projects Administration recorded authentic accounts of life in the early days of New Mexico These original documents published here as a story collection for the first time reflect the conditions of the New Mexico Territory as played out in dynamic clashes between individuals and groups competing for control of the land and resources *Frontier Stories* the second in the New Mexico Federal Writers Project Book Series after *Outlaws Desperados* features informative background and historic photographs Forthcoming books in the series include *Lost Treasures Old Mines and Stories From Hispano New Mexico*
