Since the end of World War II, many Americans and Canadians tried their hands at writing haiku. Among them, Richard Wright wrote over four thousand haiku in the final eighteen months of his life in exile in France. His *Haiku: This Other World*, ed. Yoshinobu Hakutani and Robert L.
