The story contains fictional elements. The goal is to bring history to life.

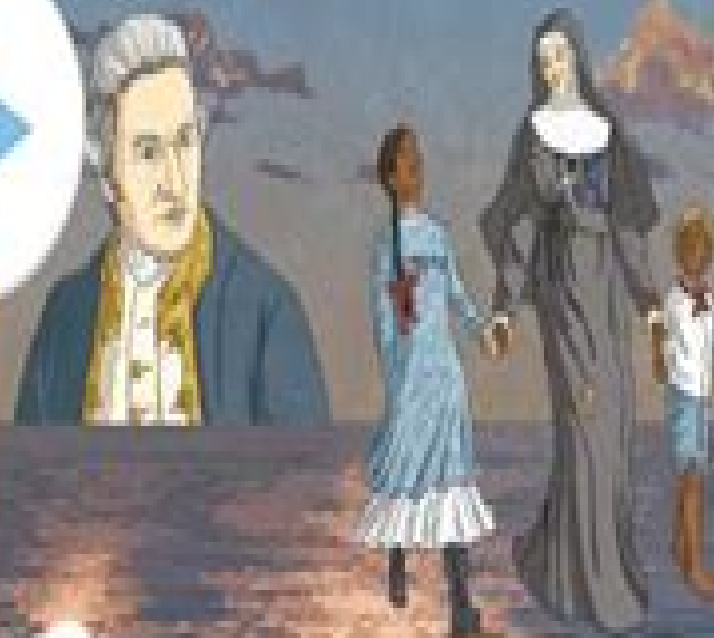
## What Is Historical Fiction?
