Activity

Recap the story 'Hornet Scramble', where the bees meet another insect that looks like them but turns out to be very different!

Write the word 'friend' on the white board and ask the children what this means to them. Children then share ideas and feedback to the class. Teacher to make notes.

Referring to the story, ask the children which characters were friendly and which characters were unfriendly? Show the children the 'What makes a good friend' PowerPoint. Ask the children to help BeeBee learn about what makes a good friend?

Differentiation

Mixed ability group, by support and by outcome.

Extension/Homework

- Children to be given friend qualities that they would then order in importance to them. The things that they look for the most in a good friend.
- Children to use the template to draw a picture about their chosen friend and then write the positives about them and why they like them.
