On Freedom Road David Goodrich, 2023-02-07 A thoughtful and illuminating bicycle journey along the Underground Railroad by a climate scientist seeking to engage with American history The traces of the Underground Railroad hide in plain sight a great church in Philadelphia a humble old house backing up to the New Jersey Turnpike an industrial outbuilding in Ohio Over the course of four years David Goodrich rode his bicycle 3 000 miles east of the Mississippi to travel the routes of the Underground Railroad and delve into the history and stories in the places where they happened He followed the most famous of conductors Harriet Tubman from where she was enslaved in Maryland on the eastern shore all the way to her family sanctuary at a tiny chapel in Ontario Canada Travelling South he rode from New Orleans where the enslaved were bought and sold through Mississippi and the heart of the Delta Blues As we pedal along with him Goodrich brings us to the Borderland along the Ohio River a kind of no mans land between North and South in the years before the Civil War Here slave hunters roamed both banks of the river trying to catch people as they fled for freedom We travel to Oberlin Ohio a town that staunchly defended freedom seekers embodied in the life of Lewis Leary who was lost in the fires of Harpers Ferry but his spirit was reborn in
