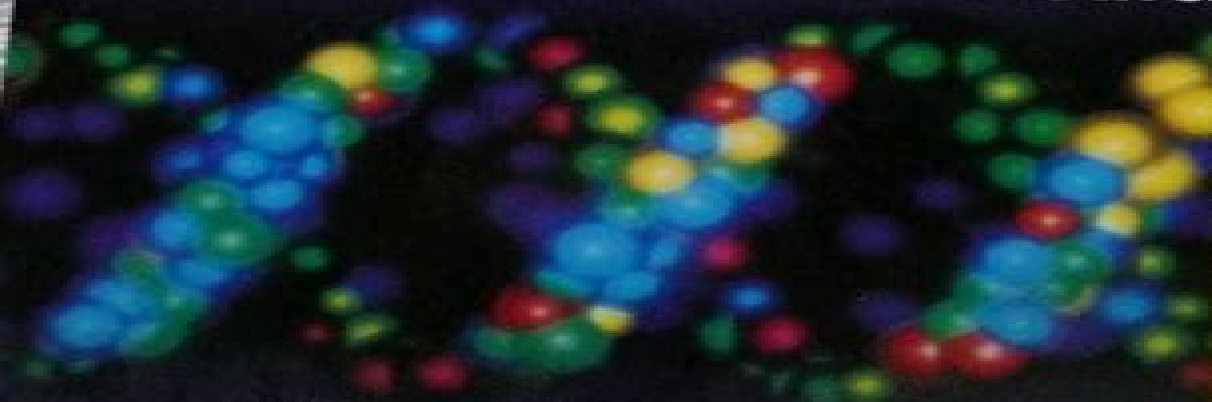

It Ain't Necessarily So Richard Lewontin, 2001-09-30 Is our nature as individuals as a species determined by our evolution and encoded in our genes If we unravel the protein sequences of our DNA will we gain the power to cure all of our physiological and psychological afflictions and even to solve the problems of our society Today biologists especially geneticists are proposing answers to questions that have long been asked by philosophy or faith or the social sciences Their work carries the weight of scientific authority and
