a result nearly all independent candidates in the local people's congress elections failed in their attempts to gain office. The prospects for this reform are also poor. The book argues that all five reforms have failed and that none will lead to China's democratization in the near future. The book concludes that the party's authoritarian regime in China is by nature anti-democratic and that so-called socialist democracy with Chinese characteristics is not democratic.
