Frequency of bribe paying fell significantly in the areas of taxes customs and imports and courts for the region overall and in most countries. The report examines several factors that influence the level of administrative corruption including regulatory burden strength of anti corruption legislation and income among others. Results show that countries with greater capacity to enforce and implement anti corruption measures are less likely to have high levels of corruption and incidence of graft. The results presented in the report show that countries of Eastern Europe and Central Asia are no longer facing higher corruption or regulatory burden than firms in comparable non transition countries.
