JURISPRUDENCE INTRODUCTION:

Jurisprudence meaning: The focus is ordering and explaining how law is to be interpreted.

Legal theory: Can include all forms of jurisprudence as well as a range of theories that are critical and draws on a huge range of disciplines form outside law

Legal philosophy: explores fundamental questions like why we have law and why people obey it

Natural law: NL is the most ancient theory and influenced western thinking since the ancient Greeks, Romans and in the time of the early Christian church. It provides guidance for the creation of the law, using reasons as the method to derive principles to guide the development of good law. Refers to 'morals' meaning 'which is good'.

 John Finnis who had a considerable influence on current ideas and responses to NL theory

Modernism and liberalism: Modernism overlapped NL in the 16th-18th centuries. They were instrumental in shaping the 'modern' world by replacing the irrational beliefs with rational, scientific and observable findings. Influenced the law in all respects, affecting our interactions with the state/right of property, assumption of liberty and freedom underpinning out society.

- Ronald Dworkin theories about law, judging and rights

Legal positivism: Emerged at the beginning of the 19th century and continued to exert a strong hold on the legal mind at the start of the 21st century. Bentham and Austin were known as the fathers of positivism and were to analyses law 'as it is'.

 Austin version of positivism was until the 1960s was considered within its own boundaries and never concerned itself with morals, society and other factors. Not good at changes in the law
