Students are shown how writers examine a potential topic, establish a stance upon that topic, defend the stance, avoid reasoning and ethical errors and in general say something meaningful about the topic. It also includes instruction about finding sources, gathering information from them and correctly documenting them. However, the emphasis remains on how effective writers evaluate sources, think about the information they discover, prepare a fair and informed argument, rethink and revise the argument and finally present an argument in its completed form.
