A more realistic model is the <u>logistic growth model</u> where growth rate is proportional to both the amount present (P) and the carrying capacity that remains: (M-P)

In this case, the growth rate is not only proportional to the current value, but also how far the current value is from the carrying capacity.

The equation then becomes:

Logistics Differential Equation

$$\frac{dP}{dt} = kP(M-P)$$

We can solve this differential equation to find the logistics growth model.
