One of the aims of this book is to offer practical ways of addressing feminist issues through an analysis of language and discourse. Feminism has long motivated and innovated gender and language studies; this book further ¹⁸ develops that legacy by providing intelligent commentary on the multi-19 faceted relationships between language and gendered patterns of social 20 disadvantage. A high level of scholarship is evident in the breadth and 21 complexity of material covered, from historical through to contemporary 22 work, with theoretical perspectives that vary in their epistemological and 23 ontological commitments, and a consideration of the multicultural con-24 texts where gender and sexuality matters differently emerge. The overarch-25 ing messages are very clear: politically relevant research is important, and 26 there is an ongoing need to maintain an open spirit of enquiry despite con-27 flicting paradigmatic commitments.

The authors suggest that gender and language studies are currently 29 entering a new stage of development, where insightful and critical analyses 30 of gender and sexuality are urgently required. It is a period of postferminism, 31 in which some women benefit from the social and political changes in the 32 wake of two waves of feminism, but gendered patterns of social deprivation 33 on a global scale remain stark. Furthermore, there is currently an unprec-34 edented (hetero)sexualisation of girls in Western media, presented in the 35 guise of postfeminist feminine freedom and choice. The authors rightly 36 point to feminist linguistics as being able to usefully illuminate the ways
