adamantly opposed Barack Obama and his policies many of them referencing Lincoln in their attacks on the current president In examining these individuals and groups Barr s study provides a deeper understanding of American political life Intellectual Agent, Mediator and Interlocutor Toyin Falola, Emmanuel M.
