Feedback: Mutations in all of these proteins, with the exception of enzymes, usually manifest in a dominant fashion. Enzyme defects are usually inherited in a recessive pattern because, if one copy of the enzyme goes, 50% activity is usually sufficient for the catalysis of most reactions. This means that most enzymatic defects only manifest when both copies are lost, hence recessive inheritance.
