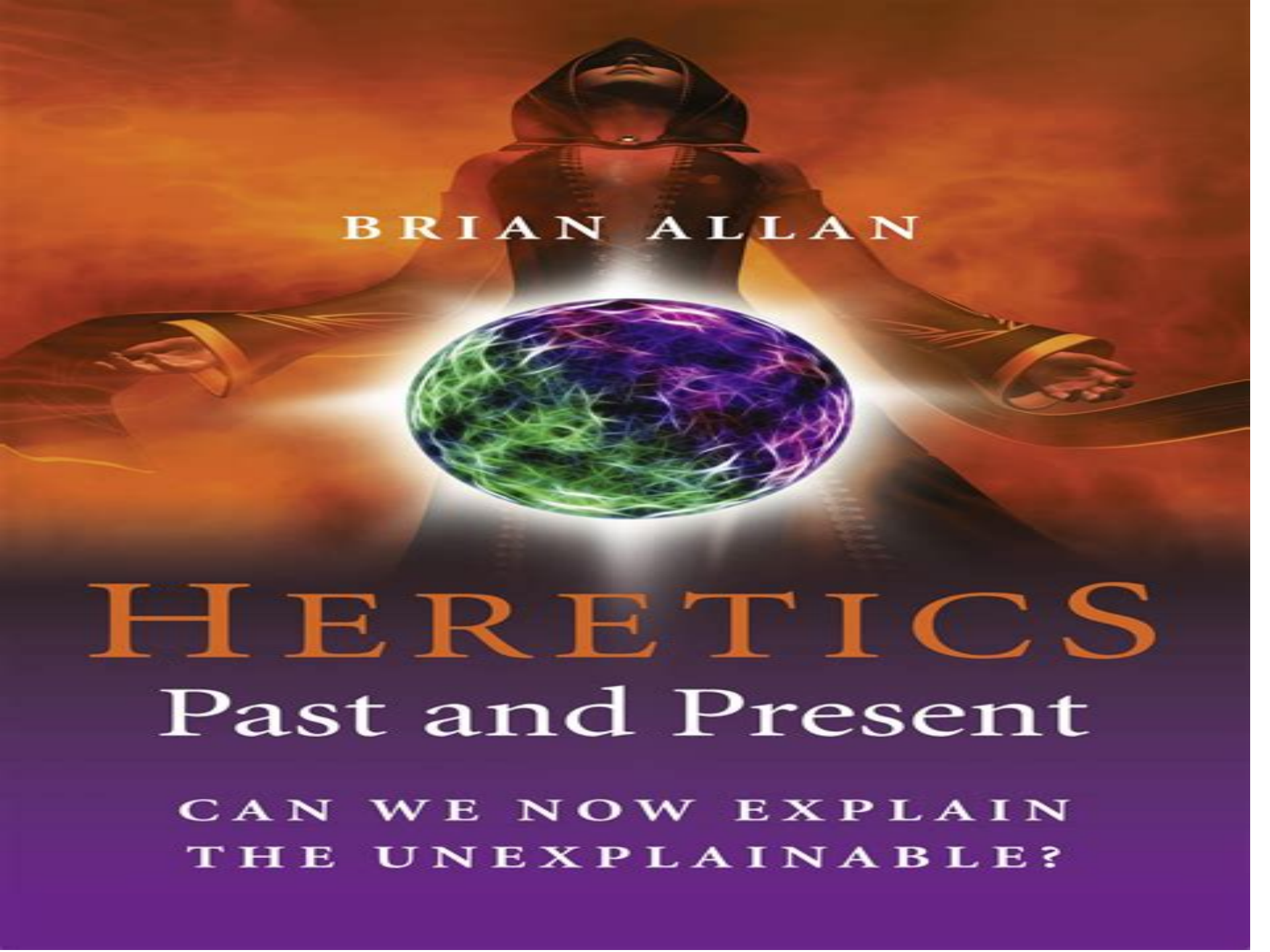

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Heretics, Past and Present John Henry Müller, 1896 **The Age of Heretics** Art Kleiner, 2008-10-03 In this second edition of his bestselling book author Art Kleiner explores the nature of effective leadership in times of change and defines its importance to the corporation of the future He describes a heretic as a visionary who creates change in large scale companies balancing the contrary truths they can't deny against their loyalty to their organizations The Age of Heretics reveals how managers can get stuck in counterproductive ways of doing things and shows why it takes a heretical point of view to get past the deadlock and move forward **Confessions of a Heretic** Eric Leland Saak, 2025-06-15 This book is the second of a planned three volume systematic theology under the title Confessions of a Heretic Volume One which has the subtitle Philosophical Considerations was published by Archway in 2024 The project now turns to Theological Considerations with the forthcoming Volume Three being Ecclesiological Consideration Organized into three Parts Volume Two focuses on the theological endeavor and the doctrines distinctive to Christianity namely the Trinity Jesus Christ sin and salvation Based on the foundational distinctions and definitions explicated in Volume One the current volume seeks to ask what the philosophical considerations imply for basic traditional understandings and terminology of Christian theology including that of Jesus of Nazareth his crucifixion and resurrection The project as a whole adopts a trinitarian structure with this second volume focused on God the Son or as here termed God the Perfector The argument is that Christian Theology needs to shift from an anthropocentric to a theocentric approach recognizing human beings simply as creatures and having the courage to face what that entails Yet doing so necessitates a radical reconceptualization of the very foundations of Christian Theology itself in the attempt to combat idolatry *The Heretic of Cacheu* Toby Green, 2025-10-06 Tells the extraordinary story of seventeenth century West African slave trader Crispina Peres to explore the shifting sophisticated world in which she lived In 1665 Crispina Peres the most powerful trader in the West African slave trafficking port of Cacheu was arrested by the Portuguese Inquisition Her enemies had conspired to denounce her for taking treatments prescribed by Senegambian healers the djabak s But who was Peres And why was the Inquisition so concerned with policing the faith of a West African woman in today's Guinea Bissau In *The Heretic of Cacheu* award winning historian Toby Green takes us to the heart of this conundrum immersing us in the atmosphere of an otherwise distant setting We learn how people in seventeenth century Cacheu built their houses styled their clothes healed themselves from illness and worshipped worked and played Green renders the haunting realities of the growing slave trade and the rise of European empires in shocking detail By the 1650s the relationships between Europe West Africa and the Americas were already old and tangled with slaving ports colonies and military bases having intermingled over many generations But Cacheu also profoundly troubled this dynamic It was globally connected to places ranging from China and India to Brazil and Colombia and women such as Crispina Peres ran the town and challenged the patriarchy of empire For the first time through surviving documents recording Peres's case *The Heretic*

of Cacheu lets readers experience the reality of this unique place and time through a remarkable act of historical recovery
