Derek Mailhiot, 2020-04-26 The opening verse in the Bible says In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth This is cosmology the science of the origin and development of the universe In creating the universe God was the Original Scientist Note the verse doesn't say when God created the universe or how God created the universe This is significant The verse doesn't say God created the universe 6 000 years ago as millions of Young Earth Creationists assert Could the beginning actually be 13.8 billion years ago like scientists claim And why do so many Christians reject the Big Bang theory God had to create the universe somehow Why couldn't that somehow be the Big Bang The Big Bang was such an awesome and enigmatic event perhaps it was an omnipotent God who triggered the Big Bang According to Old Earth Creationists the scientific evidence for the great age of the earth 4.54 billion years and the universe 13.8 billion years is undeniable But many Old Earth Creationists reject evolution opting instead for a theory of progressive creation where God created new species during creation events like the Cambrian Explosion 540 million years ago Evolutionary Creationists on the other hand also believe the Earth is millions or billions of years old and also advocate that evolution best explains how God brought about the diversity of life on Earth There
