Output and time

"The most important goal of macroeconomics is to develop an understanding of what makes income differ between countries and what makes them grow or fluctuate over time" (Gartner, p. 36)

Short and long run

- Analysis and explanations depend on time frame
- Key: what do we assume about prices?

Quantity equation $M \times V = P \times Y$

(V assumed fixed)

Long run: Y determined by production factors $\Delta M = \Delta P$

Short run: Y determined by M

$\Delta M = \Delta Y$ P assumed fixed
