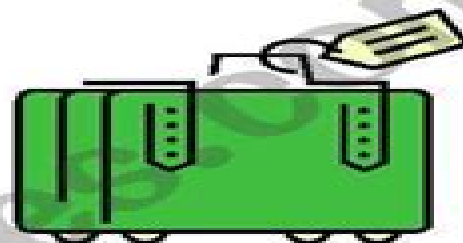


Travel Writing
