Letters from the Lost Helen Waldstein Wilkes, 2010 On March 15 1939 Helen Waldstein's father snatched his stamped exit visa from a distracted clerk to escape from Prague with his wife and child As the Nazis closed in on a war torn Czechoslovakia only letters from their extended family could reach Canada through the barriers of conflict The Waldstein family received these letters as they made their lives on a southern Ontario farm where they learned to be Canadian and forget their Jewish roots Helen Waldstein read these letters as an adult this changed everything As her past refused to keep silent Helen followed the trail of the letters back to Europe where she discovered living witnesses who could attest to the letters contents She has here interwoven their stories and her own into a compelling narrative of suffering survivor guilt and overcoming intergenerational obstacles when exploring a traumatic past

Chasing Portraits Elizabeth Rynecki, 2016-09-06 The memoir of one woman's emotional quest to find the art of her Polish Jewish great grandfather lost during World War II Moshe Rynecki's body of work reached close to eight hundred paintings and sculptures before his life came to a tragic end It was his great granddaughter Elizabeth who sought to rediscover his legacy setting upon a journey to seek out what had been lost but never forgotten The everyday lives of the Polish Jewish community depicted in Moshe Rynecki's paintings simply blended into the background of Elizabeth Rynecki's life when she was growing up But the art transformed from familiar to extraordinary in her eyes after her grandfather Moshe's son George left behind journals detailing the loss her ancestors had endured during World War II including Moshe's art Knowing that her family had only found a small portion of Moshe's art and that many more pieces remained to be found Elizabeth set out to find them Before Moshe was deported to the ghetto he entrusted his work to friends who would keep it safe After he was killed in the Majdanek concentration camp the art was dispersed all over the world With the help of historians curators and admirers of Moshe's work Elizabeth began the incredible and difficult task of rebuilding his collection Spanning three decades of Elizabeth's life and three generations of her family this touching memoir is a compelling narrative of the richness of one man's art the devastation of war and one woman's unexpected path to healing
