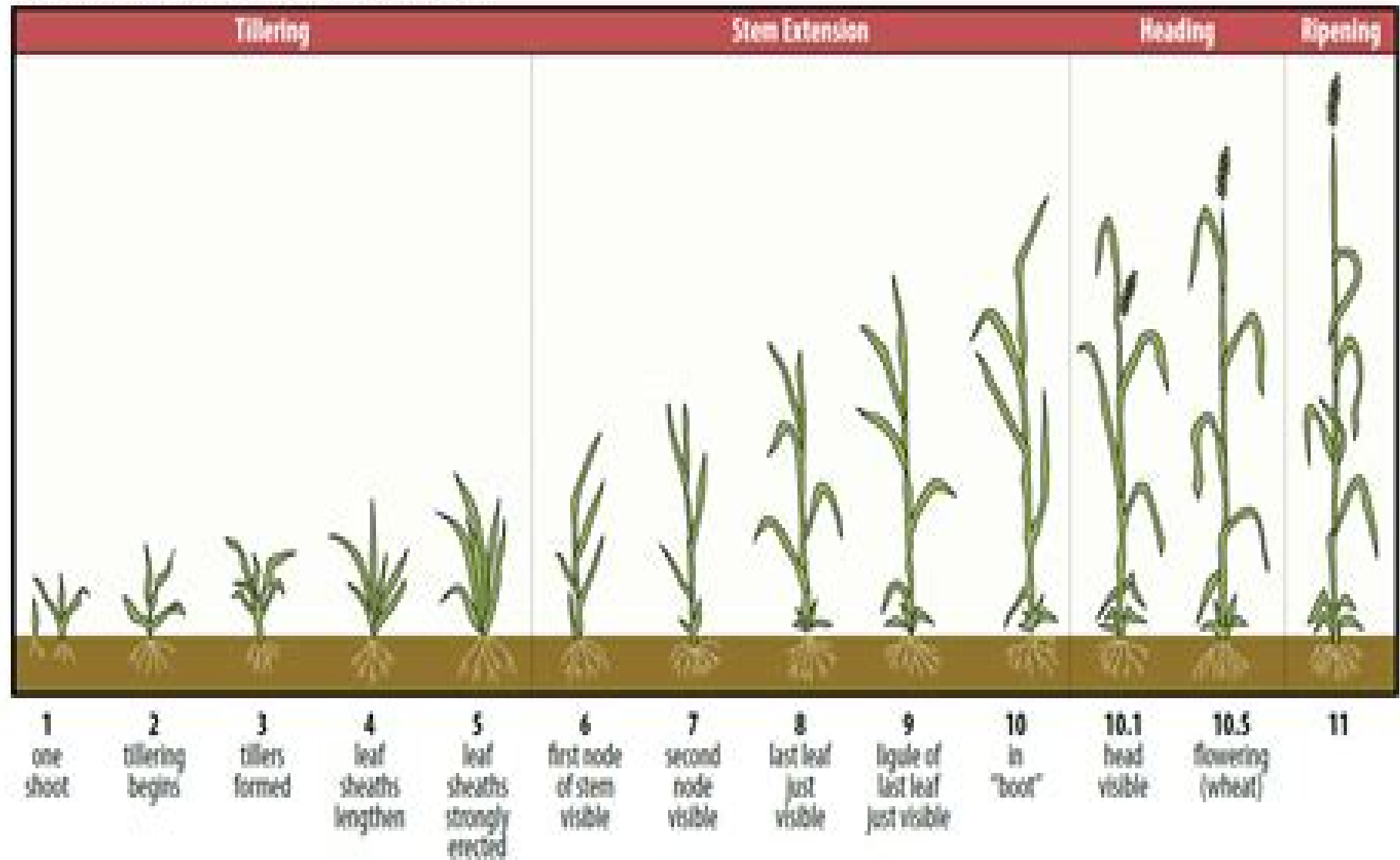


Figure 2-1. The feekes scale of wheat development.
