

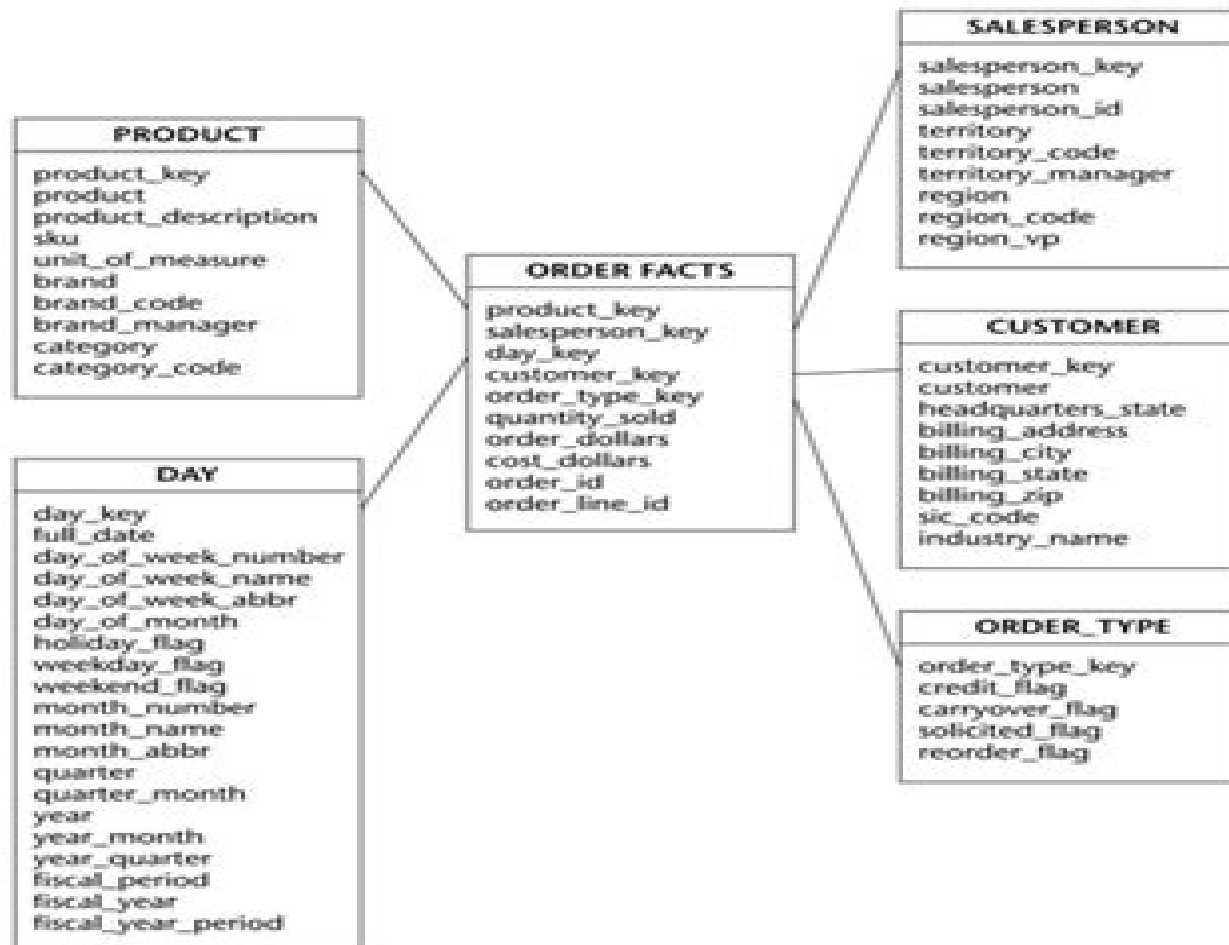


Figure 1.2 A star schema for the orders process.
