Topic 5.1 The Enlightenment

Learning Objective

Explain the intellectual and ideological context in which revolutions swept the Atlantic world from 1750 to 1900.

Historical Developments

Enlightenment philosophies applied new ways of understanding and empiricism encompassed to both the natural world and human relationships; they also reexamined the role that religion played in public life and emphasized the importance of reason. Philosophers developed new political ideas about the individual, natural rights, and the social contract.

The rise and diffusion of Enlightenment thought that questioned established traditions in all areas of life often preceded revolutions and rebellions against existing governments.

Nationalism also became a major force shaping the historical development of states and empires.

1. Explain the ideas of the Enlightenment.

Individual liberty and religious tolerance, as opposed to absolute monarchy and the unchanging beliefs of the Church, were the two main tenets of the Enlightenment.

2. How were these ideas considered changes from previous philosophies/mindsets?

Enlightenment intellectuals questioned the traditional methods of doing things, regardless of whether they were mandates from the European monarchies and religions or long-standing custom. When philosophers discovered a principle to reject, they replaced it by posing significant and pertinent questions, then responding to those questions with resources like their own knowledge, empirical data, and the use of logic and reason.

3. What factors facilitated the spread of Enlightenment ideals within and outside of Europe?

The encyclopedia, salons, and printing presses. Eventually, they were disseminated via publications, leaflets, and political songs.

4. Explain natural rights.

Natural rights are universal and inalienable since they are not governed by any one culture's or government's laws, traditions, or beliefs. People have an inherent right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of property, according to Locke, a philosopher of the period.

5. Explain the social contract.

A belief that all people cede some of their own freedoms to a group or government, but that group or government must use its power under specified conditions. The general will, one of the most significant duties of any government, may be imposed by the entire body, the people and the government. The people have power over the government through some form of expression of what the people desire.

6. Explain nationalism and how it will later play an important role in the political revolutions of the 18th and 19th centuries.

Nationalism is a strong attachment to individuals who share one's language and culture. The concept of people who share a culture living in an autonomous nation-state.

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
