Parts I & II – IDs (50 points total)

Listed below are the key terms that you will be expected to study and prepare to answer for the final exam. You will be tested on these terms in two (2) ways:

Part I will consist of twenty (20) matching questions where you must match a term/event/individual with its appropriate definition. Each answer will be worth two (2) points for a total of **forty (40) points**.

Part II will consist of five (5) multiple choice questions related to the central definition of each term. Each answer will be worth two (2) points for a total of **ten (10) points**.

****As you study, consider how these IDs/terms relate to the following: change over time, historical conflict, historical ambiguities, and how these people, events, or institutions connect to the broader themes in U.S. History we have analyzed.****

Double V for Victory – Campaign called for African Americans to fight WWII on two fronts: 1) victory abroad protecting American Democracy from Fascism and 2) victory at home in eradicating racial discrimination.

Brown vs. Board of Education (1954) – The U.S. Supreme court ruled that the U.S. state laws establishing racial segregation in public schools are unconstitutional, even if the segregated schools are otherwise equal in quality.

Executive Order #9802 – Racial discrimination is illegal in industries vital to war effort.

A. Philip Randolph – Calls for March on Washington (1941) for blacks to demand racial equality in the military and war production sectors.

"The Four Freedoms" – Freedom of Speech, Freedom of Worship, Freedom from Want, Freedom from Fear.

Civil Rights Act (1964) – Banned discrimination in public accommodations; banned discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, and sex by employers and labor unions; allowed government agencies to withhold federal money and initiate proceedings against segregation.

Bracero Program – U.S. – Mexico agreement where Mexican immigrants work in domestic and agricultural sectors to fill labor shortage during WWII; temporary program extends until 1964. Bracero's lack of rights illustrated limitations of pathways to citizenship for Mexican immigrants.

Voting Rights Act (1965) – Prohibits states from imposing any "voting qualifications or prerequisite to voting, or standard, practice, or procedure ... to deny or abridge the right of any citizen of the U.S. to vote on account of race or color."

Korematsu vs. United States (1942) – Supreme court upholds legality of internment. Internment is the state of being confined as a prisoner, especially for political or military reasons.
