Mathematics, Matter and Method: Volume 1 Hilary Putnam,2012-05-11 **Rationality and Logic** Robert Hanna,2009-01-23 An argument that logic is intrinsically psychological and human psychology is intrinsically logical and that the connection between human rationality and logic is both constitutive and mutual In *Rationality and Logic* Robert Hanna argues that logic is intrinsically psychological and that human psychology is intrinsically logical He claims that logic is cognitively constructed by rational animals including humans and that rational animals are essentially logical animals In order to do so he defends the broadly Kantian thesis that all and only rational animals possess an innate cognitive logic faculty Hanna s claims challenge the conventional philosophical wisdom that sees logic as a fully formal or topic neutral science irreconcilably separate from the species or individual specific focus of empirical psychology Logic and psychology went their separate ways after attacks by Frege and Husserl on logical psychologism the explanatory reduction of logic to empirical psychology Hanna argues however that despite the fact that logical psychologism is false there is an essential link between logic and psychology Rational human animals constitute the basic class of cognizers or thinkers studied by cognitive psychology given the connection between rationality and logic that Hanna claims it follows that the nature of logic is significantly revealed to us by cognitive psychology Hanna s proposed logical cognitivism has two important consequences the recognition by logically oriented philosophers that psychologists are their colleagues in the metadiscipline of cognitive science and radical changes in cognitive science itself Cognitive science Hanna argues is not at bottom a natural science it is both an objective or truth oriented science and a normative human science as is logic itself *The Uses of Sense* Charles Travis,1989-03-09 *The Uses of Sense* provides a novel account of Wittgenstein s view of language as expressed in the *Philosophical Investigations* On the account Wittgenstein s view is a radical break with a still dominant Fregean tradition Travis applies this account to show the significance of private language and of other major themes in the *Investigations* such as family resemblance and language games Wittgenstein uses the idea of private language for a thought experiment What is the experiment meant to test Travis suggests that it is two pictures of the having of semantic properties by whatever items might do so that are at stake One picture is Fregean The other is opposed to it in denying a certain fixity in the semantic properties of an item which for example might permit simply defining some items as the bearers of such and such semantics On Wittgenstein s picture the semantics of any item is variable across occasions for viewing it or using it This variability arises through the dependence of any item s semantics on its users and their uses of it This dependence requires publicity of

a sort excluded by private language If items may still have semantics privately Travis argues then Wittgenstein s picture may not be compulsory But if semantics collapses under such unnatural conditions then in ways Wittgenstein indicates that shows something fundamentally mistaken in the Fregean approach

David Stump traces alternative conceptions of the a priori in the philosophy of science and defends a unique position in the current debates over conceptual change and the constitutive elements in science Stump emphasizes the unique epistemological status of the constitutive elements of scientific theories constitutive elements being the necessary preconditions that must be assumed in order to conduct a particular scientific inquiry These constitutive elements such as logic mathematics and even some fundamental laws of nature were once taken to be a priori knowledge but can change thus leading to a dynamic or relative a priori Stump critically examines developments in thinking about constitutive elements in science as a priori knowledge from Kant s fixed and absolute a priori to Quine s holistic empiricism By examining the relationship between conceptual change and the epistemological status of constitutive elements in science Stump puts

forward an argument that scientific revolutions can be explained and relativism can be avoided without resorting to universals or absolutes

Kulp, 2019-08-14 This is a book on metaethics in particular an inquiry into the metaphysical foundations of morality After carefully exploring the metaphysical commitments or lack thereof of the leading versions of moral anti realism Kulp develops a new and in depth theory of moral realism Starting with the firm recognition of the importance of our common sense belief that we possess a great deal of moral knowledge that for example some acts are objectively right and some objectively wrong the book goes on to examine the metaphysical grounds of various skeptical responses to this perspective In great part the book is devoted to developing a version of realist metaethics specifically developing in detail realist theories of moral truth moral facts and moral properties Concluding with the rejection of prominent contemporary forms of moral anti realism Kulp presents a rigorous non naturalistic theory of moral realism and a vindication of the basic commitments of commonsense moral thought

Fundamental Causation Christopher Gregory Weaver, 2018-08-06 *Fundamental Causation* addresses issues in the metaphysics of deterministic singular causation the metaphysics of events property instances facts preventions and omissions as well as the debate between causal reductionists and causal anti reductionists The book also pays special attention to causation and causal structure in physics Weaver argues that causation is a multigrade obtaining relation that is transitive irreflexive and asymmetric When causation is singular deterministic and such that it relates purely contingent events the relation is also universal intrinsic and well founded He shows that proper causal relata are events understood as states of substances at ontological indices He then proves that causation cannot be reduced to some non causal base and that the best account of that relation should be unashamedly primitivist about the dependence relation that underwrites its very nature The book demonstrates a distinctive realist and anti reductionist account of causation by detailing precisely how the account outperforms reductionist and competing anti reductionist accounts in that it handles all of the difficult cases while overcoming all of the general objections to anti reductionism upon which other anti reductionist accounts falter This book offers an original and interesting view of causation and will appeal to scholars and advanced students in the areas of metaphysics philosophy of science and philosophy of physics

Structure and the Metaphysics of Mind William Jaworski, 2016-03-04 *Structure and the Metaphysics of Mind* is the first book to show how hylomorphism can be used to solve mind body problems persistent problems understanding how thought feeling perception and other mental phenomena fit into the physical world described by our best science Hylomorphism claims that structure is a basic ontological and explanatory principle Some individuals paradigmatically living things consist of materials that are structured or organized in various ways Those structures are responsible for individuals being the kinds of things they are and having the kinds of powers or capacities they have From a hylomorphic perspective mind body problems are byproducts of a worldview that rejects structure Hylomorphic structure carves out distinctive individuals from the otherwise undifferentiated sea of matter and

energy described by our best physics and it confers on those individuals distinctive powers including the powers to think feel and perceive A worldview that rejects hylomorphic structure lacks a basic principle which distinguishes the parts of the physical universe that can think feel and perceive from those that can't and without such a principle the existence of those powers in the physical world can start to look inexplicable and mysterious But if mental phenomena are structural phenomena as hylomorphism claims then they are uncontroversially part of the physical world for on the hylomorphic view structure is uncontroversially part of the physical world Hylomorphism thus provides an elegant way of solving mind body problems
