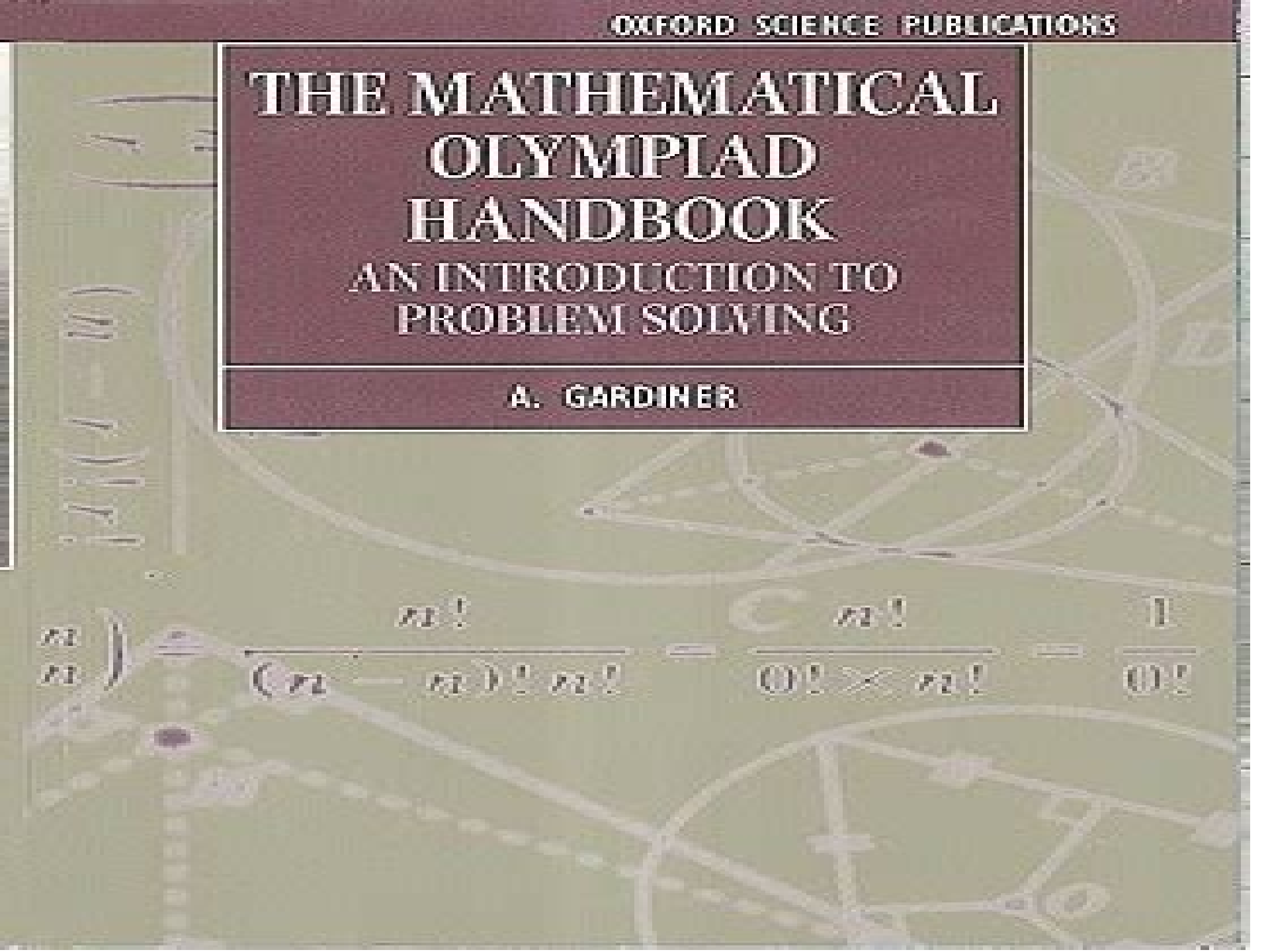

The Mathematical Olympiad Handbook Anthony Gardiner, 1997 Mathematical Olympiad competitions started in Hungary at the end of the nineteenth century and are now held internationally They bring together able secondary school pupils who attempt to solve problems which develop their mathematical skills Olympiad problems are unpredictable and have no obvious starting point and although they require only the skills learnt in ordinary school problems they can seem much harder The Mathematical Olympiad Handbook introduces readers to these challenging problems and aims to convince them that Olympiads are not just for a select minority The book contains problems from the first 32 British Mathematical Olympiad BMO papers 1965-96 and gives hints and outline solutions to each problem from 1975 onwards An overview is given of the basic mathematical skills needed and a list of books for further reading is provided Working through the exercises provides a valuable source of extension and enrichment for all pupils and adults interested in mathematics

miscellaneous problems in the final toolchest An unusual feature of this book is the attention paid throughout to the history of mathematics the origins of the ideas the terminology and some of the problems and the celebration of mathematics as a multicultural cooperative human achievement As a bonus the aspiring mathlete may encounter in the most enjoyable way possible many of the topics that form the core of the standard school curriculum

explores the representations of integer numbers in different bases and examines continued fractions quadratic irrationalities and the Lagrange Theorem The last section of Chapter Two is an exploration of different methods of proofs The third chapter is dedicated to solving Diophantine linear and nonlinear equations and includes different methods of solving Fermat's Pell's equations It also covers Fermat's factorization techniques and methods of solving challenging problems involving exponent and factorials Chapter Four reviews the Pythagorean triple and quadruple and emphasizes their connection with geometry trigonometry algebraic geometry and stereographic projection A special case of Waring's problem as a representation of a number by the sum of the squares or cubes of other numbers is covered as well as quadratic residuals Legendre and Jacobi symbols and interesting word problems related to the properties of numbers Appendices provide a historic overview of number theory and its main developments from the ancient cultures in Greece Babylon and Egypt to the modern day Drawing from cases collected by an accomplished female mathematician *Methods in Solving Number Theory Problems* is designed as a self study guide or supplementary textbook for a one semester course in introductory number theory It can also be used to prepare for mathematical Olympiads Elementary algebra arithmetic and some calculus knowledge are the only prerequisites Number theory gives precise proofs and theorems of an irreproachable rigor and sharpens analytical thinking which makes this book perfect for anyone looking to build their mathematical confidence
