A high tech industrial cluster such as Silicon Valley is characterized by concentrated entrepreneurship. Following Schumpeter, we emphasize the fact that the appearance of one or a few entrepreneurs facilitates the appearance of others. Schumpeter 1934. We propose an agent-based computational model to show how high tech industrial clusters could emerge in a landscape in which no firms existed originally. The model is essentially a spatial version of the Nelson-Winter model. Boundedly rational agents are scattered over an explicitly defined landscape. Each agent is endowed with some technology which determines his firm's productivity if he has one. During each period of time, an agent with no firm would make a decision as to whether he wants to start one.
