projected to rise by 400% as the population ages At the same time it is important to observe that the older population as a whole is neither helpless nor dependent Most older people are capable of coping and adapting despite increasing poor health and frailty as they age Older people contribute immeasurably to their families and communities in various roles and commonly sacrifice their well being to help their children and grandchildren In Africa the HIV AIDS epidemic has seen older persons assume responsibility for raising many thousands of orphaned grandchildren and other children in need Finally older people contribute to their communities their decades of accumulated experience knowledge and understanding This insight makes them an essential resource and potential partner in developing emergency preparedness and response programmes
