

Alexander, 2023-09-26 At 14 259 feet Longs Peak towers over Colorado's northern Front Range A prized location for mountaineering since the 1870s Longs has been a place of astonishing climbing feats and unsurprisingly of significant risk and harm Careless and unlucky climbers have experienced serious injury and death on the peak while their activities equipment and trash have damaged fragile alpine resources As a site of outdoor adventure attracting mostly white people Longs has mirrored the United States tenacious racial divides even into the twenty first century In telling the history of Longs Peak and its climbers Ruth M Alexander shows how Rocky Mountain National Park like the National Park Service NPS has struggled to contend with three fundamental obligations to facilitate visitor enjoyment protect natural resources and manage the park as a site of democracy Too often it has treated these obligations as competing rather than complementary commitments reflecting national discord over their meaning and value Yet the history of Longs also shows us how over time climbers the park and the NPS have attempted to align these obligations in policy and practice By putting mountain climbers and their relationship to Longs Peak and its rangers at the center of the story of Rocky Mountain National Park Alexander exposes the significant role outdoor recreationists have had as both citizens and privileged adventurers in shaping the peak's meaning use and management Since 2000 the park has promoted climber enjoyment and safety helped preserve the environment facilitated tribal connections to the park and attracted a more diverse group of visitors and climbers Yet Alexander argues more work needs to be done Alexander's nuanced account of Longs Peak reveals the dangers of undermining national parks fundamental obligations and presents a powerful appeal to meet them fairly and fully

Horses Don't Fly Frederick Libby, 2012-03-15 From breaking wild horses in Colorado to fighting the Red Baron's squadrons in the skies over France here in his own words is the true story of a forgotten American hero the cowboy who became our first ace and the first pilot to fly the American colors over enemy lines. Growing up on a ranch in Sterling Colorado Frederick Libby mastered the cowboy arts of roping punching cattle and taming horses. As a young man he exercised his skills in the mountains and on the ranges of Arizona and New Mexico as well as the Colorado prairie. When World War I broke out he found himself in Calgary Alberta and joined the Canadian army. In France he transferred to the Royal Flying Corps as an observer the gunner in a two person biplane. Libby shot down an enemy plane on his first day in battle over the Somme which was also the first day he flew in a plane or fired a machine gun. He went on to become a pilot. He fought against the legendary German aces Oswald Boelcke and Manfred von Richthofen and became the first American to down five enemy planes. He won the Military Cross for conspicuous gallantry in action. Libby's memoir of his cowboy days in the last years of the Old West evokes a real life Cormac McCarthy novel. His description of World War I combines a rattling good account of the air war over France with captivating and sometimes poignant depictions of wartime London the sorrow for friends lost in combat and the courage and camaraderie of the Royal Flying Corps.
