Lecturas compulsivas Félix de Azúa, 1998 Una reciente encuesta informaba de que en los últimos veinte años y entre los más jóvenes el hábito de leer ha descendido a la mitad El autor de los artículos recogidos en este libro lleva veinte años animando a la lectura mediante el único método eficaz conocido tratando de comunicar su propio entusiasmo por algunos libros y autores En lugar de dar por perdida la batalla de la lectura Azúa ha reunido una nutrida galería de alabanzas literarias por si alguien quiere compartir con ella la pasión por la literatura Así comparecen entre otros Stendhal y Flaubert Henry James y Faulkner Beckett y Cioran Novalis y Rimbaud y también los Novsimos y dedica especial atención a Kafka Bernhard Ferlosio y Benet Y no falta una sección dedicada a escudriñar para qué sirve la literatura y otra a Madrid Barcelona mediante Cansinos Assens y Josep Maria de Sagarra En estos artículos Félix de Azúa busca una participación inmediata del lector y evita la prosa académica o el ensayo especializado su intención es la de dar a conocer ciertos libros poco divulgados o comentar otros tan celebres que ya casi nadie se molesta en leerlos o dar una rápida estampa de algunos escritores relevantes de la modernidad con la única finalidad de que su texto sea tan sólo una invitación para acudir al original No falta algún comentario escrito por el puro placer de recordar como un cinéfilo rememorando gozosamente su película favorita El autor cree con George Steiner que nada puede sustituir la presencia real del libro comentado pero también sabe que casi todo el mundo mira la foto y lee la solapa antes de comprarlo Digamos que en este libro ha reunido las fotos y solapas que le han parecido más presentables El resultado es un libro de lectura también compulsiva

Libros, lecturas y otras verdades adolescentes, **Javier Marías's Debt to Translation** Gareth J. Wood, 2012-05-03 This is a book about translation and literary influence It takes as its subject Spain's most important contemporary novelist Javier Marías 1951 who worked as a literary translator for a significant portion of his early career Since then he has maintained that translation had a crucial impact on the development of his writing style and his literary frame of reference It examines his claims to the influence of three writers whose works he translated Laurence Sterne Sir Thomas Browne and Vladimir Nabokov It does so by engaging in close reading of his translations examining how he meets the linguistic syntactic and cultural challenges they present His prolonged engagement with their prose is then set alongside his own novels and short stories the better to discern precisely how and in what ways his works have been shaped

by their influence and through translation Hence this study begins by asking why Mar as should have turned to translation in the cultural landscape of Spain in the 1970s and how the ideological standpoints that animated his decision affect the way he translates His translation of Sterne's *Life and Opinions of Tristram Shandy Gentleman* is set alongside his pseudo autobiographical novel *Negra espalda del tiempo* *Dark Back of Time* while his translation of Sir Thomas Browne's *Urn Burial* is then analysed in tandem with that produced by Jorge Luis Borges and Adolfo Bioy Casares Subsequent chapters examine how Browne's prose has shaped Mar as's thinking on oblivion posterity and time The final chapters offer an analysis of the partial translation and palimpsest of *Lolita* he undertook in the early 1990s and of his most ambitious novel to date *Tu rostro ma ana* *Your Face Tomorrow* as a work in which characterization is underpinned by both literary allusion and the hybridization of works Mar as has translated

Thomas Bernhard's Afterlives Olaf Berwald, Stephen D.
