

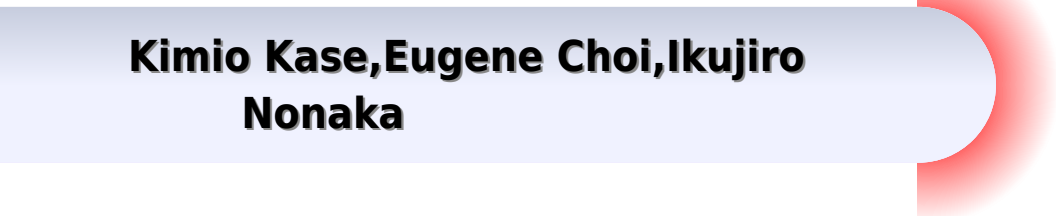

It construes how Inamori's management philosophy disciplines accounting and finance management towards putting its basic tenets into practice. Examining in particular the history of Kyocera the authors provide a contemplative look at a human-centric philosophy which will be of interest to scholars of management, corporate executives and economists with a philosophical bent.

The Theory and Practice of Zen Buddhism Charles S.
