

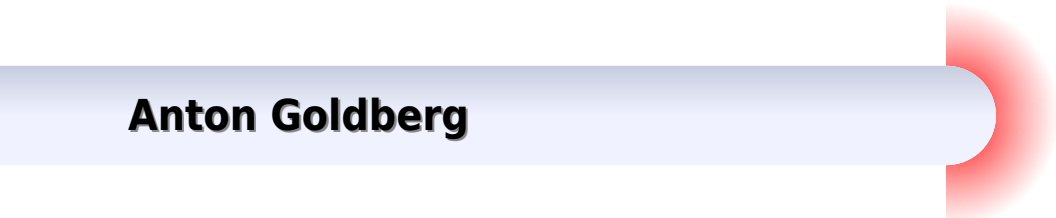

reason these are good books for a child to own an occasional re reading will inspire in him a healthy normal taste in reading Many of the stories are of value to read to very young children They guide an exuberant imagination along natural channels
