Grundfragen der antiken Sklaverei Elisabeth Herrmann-Otto, 2015-06-17 Trotz der Abschaffung von Sklaverei und Sklavenhandel im 19. Jahrhundert und trotz wiederholter Verkündung der Menschenrechte im 20./21. Jahrhundert erlebt die Sklaverei in vielfältigen Formen in unserer globalisierten Welt einen Aufschwung ungeahnten Ausmaßes. Da Versklavung und Sklavenhaltung ein Phänomen der Menschheitsgeschichte zu sein scheinen, wird hier eine Rückbesinnung auf die Grundfragen der antiken Sklaverei vorgelegt, die sich mit Theorie und Praxis dieser mehr als tausendjährigen in der Antike selbstverständlichen Institution auseinandersetzt. Ziel der Untersuchungen ist unter anderem der Versuch einer Antwort auf die Frage, ob es Ähnlichkeiten zwischen der heutigen und der antiken Sklaverei gibt oder ob den antiken Gesellschaften ein ganz anderes politisches, ökonomisches und ethisch-philosophisches Selbstverständnis zugrunde liegt. Zu diesem Zweck werden die Motive zur Sklavenhaltung und die theoretischen Grundlagen der Sklaverei einer quellenbasierten Analyse unterzogen. Despite the abolition of slavery and the slave trade in the 19th century and despite repeated proclamations of human rights in the 20th and 21st centuries, slavery in many forms is experiencing a revival on an unforeseen scale in our globalised world. Since enslavement and slave owning appear to be a phenomenon of human history, this study returns to the basic issues surrounding ancient slavery and examines the theory and practice of an institution which was taken for granted for over a thousand years in the ancient world. One of the aims of the study is to try and answer the question of whether there are similarities between contemporary and ancient slavery or whether the self-conception of ancient societies had a completely different political, economic and ethical-philosophical basis. To this end, the motives for slave owning and the theoretical foundations of slavery are subjected to a source-based analysis.

Norms of Dependency in Late Antique and Early Medieval Societies Martin Schermaier, Julia Winnebeck, Matthias Becher, 2025-06-02 Late antique and early medieval normative sources frequently employ Roman legal terminology to denote a person's legal inferiority and thus suggest the continued relevance of the concepts associated with these terms. However, it is far from clear to what extent the use of identical terminology actually indicates the similarity of social phenomena. There is ample evidence of important changes regarding the rights and duties of enslaved persons and the development or emergence of other new forms of asymmetrical dependency. This raises the question to what extent consistency in terminology and legal practice is actually an indicator of the stability of social structures. Against this background, a group of scholars of legal, ecclesiastical and social history were invited to a conference at the BCDSS in March 2022 to scrutinise different law codes and legal sources for their evidence of dependency. The result are these ten papers that truly enhance our understanding of slavery and other dependency relations in late antique and early medieval societies from c. 100 to c. 900 CE.

Theologie und Sklaverei von der Antike bis in die frühe Neuzeit Nicole Priesching, Heike Grieser, 2016-04-01 Die Institution der Sklaverei ist länger als das Christentum. Die Forschung hat immer wieder auf den humanisierenden Einfluss der christlichen Erlösungsreligion aufmerksam gemacht. In

der auch Sklaven als Menschen in den Blick genommen wurden. Doch auch unter christlichen Vorzeichen existierte Sklaverei weiter und geht noch bis ins 19. Jahrhundert hinein zur Realität christlicher und muslimischer Gesellschaften im Mittelmeerraum. Wie ließe sich diese Praxis mit dem Christentum vereinbaren, das jeden Menschen als Ebenbild Gottes versteht? Die acht Beiträge dieses Sammelbandes sind aus einem von der DFG geförderten gleichnamigen Forschungsprojekt hervorgegangen. Sie widmen sich dieser Frage erstmals in einem theologiegeschichtlichen Zugriff. So werden Humanisierungstendenzen und ihre Grenzen bei christlichen Autoren vom 2. bis zum 17. Jahrhundert und Tatian, Basilios von Caesarea, Johannes Chrysostomus, Thomas von Aquin, Martin Luther, Cornelius a Lapide und im Mönchtum herausgearbeitet. Dabei lassen sich neue Einsichten in Legitimations- und Bewältigungsstrategien sowie Rezeptionsprozesse gewinnen. The institution of slavery pre-dates Christianity. Scholarship has often drawn attention to the humanising influence of the Christian religion of salvation which views slaves too as human. But slavery continued to exist in Christian contexts and until the 19th century formed part of the reality of Christian and Muslim societies in the Mediterranean region. How could this practice be reconciled with Christianity which sees all people as made in God's image? The eight contributions to this volume have their origins in a DFG-sponsored project of the same name. For the first time they approach this question from the perspective of the history of theology, examining humanising tendencies and their limits in the work of Christian authors from the 2nd to the 17th century, including Tatian, Basil of Caesarea, John Chrysostom, Thomas Aquinas, Martin Luther and Cornelius a Lapide and in monasticism. This approach offers new insights into strategies of legitimisation and coping and into processes of reception.

The Position of Roman Slaves Martin Schermaier, 2023-03-06. Slaves were property of their dominus, objects rather than persons without rights. These are some components of our basic knowledge about Roman slavery. But Roman slavery was more diverse than we might assume from the standard wording about servile legal status. Numerous inscriptions as well as literary and legal sources reveal clear differences in the social structure of Roman slavery. There were numerous groups and professions who shared the status of being unfree while inhabiting very different worlds. The papers in this volume pose the question of whether and how legal texts reflected such social differences within the Roman servile community. Did the legal system reinscribe social differences and if so in what shape? Were exceptions created only in individual cases or did the legal system generate privileges for particular groups of slaves? Did it reinforce and even promote social differentiation? All papers probe neuralgic points that are apt to challenge the homogeneous image of Roman slave law. They show that this law was a good deal more colourful than historical research has so far assumed. The authors' primary concern is to make this legal diversity accessible to historical scholarship.

Frühes Christentum und antike Sklaverei Bernd Kollmann, 2025-04-14. Die Haltung des frühen Christentums gegenüber der Sklaverei steht immer wieder in der Kritik. Seit dem späten 19. Jh. werden Paulus und weitere neutestamentliche Autoren mit dem Vorwurf bedacht, sie hätten die inhumane Praxis der Sklaverei nicht nur befürwortet, sondern auch noch theologisch untermauert, anstatt sie im Geiste des Liebesgebots Jesu

anzuprangern und energisch zu bekämpfen. Vor diesem Hintergrund setzt sich die vorliegende Studie die Aufgabe, die in den Schriften des Urchristentums erkennbare Positionierung der Autoren zur Institution der Sklaverei präzise herauszuarbeiten, um sie dann unter Einbeziehung der Frage nach Alleinstellungsmerkmalen vergleichend in ihr antikes Umfeld einzuordnen. Dazu bedarf es zunächst einer Sichtung dessen, welche Theorien und Formen der Sklaverei in der griechisch-römischen Welt und im antiken Judentum ausgeprägt waren. Danach richtet sich der Fokus auf die Sklavengleichnisse Jesu und die Aussagen der neutestamentlichen Briefliteratur zur Sklaventhematik wie Sklavenmetaphorik. Abgerundet wird die Darstellung durch einen Blick auf das von frühem außerkanonischen Schriften vermittelte Bild der Sklaverei. Am Ende steht ein differenziertes Urteil darüber, inwieweit die frühchristlichen Autoren im Rahmen des in ihrer Zeit Denkbaren und Möglichen einen hinreichenden Beitrag zur kritischen Auseinandersetzung mit der inhumanen Praxis der Sklaverei geleistet haben. Dabei zeigt sich, dass dem Apostel Paulus vor dem Hintergrund seiner apokalyptischen Naherwartung und einer rechtsgeschichtlichen Neubewertung des Philemonbriefs wenig vorgeworfen werden kann während das nachpaulinische Zeitalter durch vertane Chancen zur Verbesserung der Situation von Sklavinnen und Sklaven gekennzeichnet ist. Insgesamt sind in der frühchristlichen Literatur kaum emanzipatorische Impulse oder hoffnungsstiftende Visionen im Hinblick auf die Überwindung der Sklaverei erkennbar.

The Popes, the Catholic Church and the Transatlantic Enslavement of Black Africans 1418-1839 Pius Onyemechi Adiele, 2017-09-01

Mehr als 400 Jahre lang erlitten schwarzafrikanische Männer, Frauen und Kinder während des transatlantischen Sklavenhandels schlimmste Formen der Versklavung und Erniedrigung durch Katholiken und das westliche Christentum. Damals wie heute glaubte niemand an die tiefe Verwicklung der Kirche und des Papsttums in den schwarzafrikanischen Holocaust. Trotz jüngster Behauptungen des päpstlichen Offiziums in Rom, wonach die Päpste jegliche Form von Sklaverei verurteilten, so auch im Falle der Versklavung von Schwarzafrikanern, verweisen neuere Studien innerhalb dieses Forschungsfeldes auf das Gegenteil. Die Kirche und die Päpste nahmen vielmehr zentrale Rollen in diesem schlimmsten Verbrechen gegen die Schwarzafrikaner seit Beginn der schriftlichen Dokumentation ein. Mithilfe zahlreicher päpstlicher Bullen aus den Geheimarchiven des Vatikans und einer Vielzahl an königlichen Dokumenten aus dem portugiesischen Nationalarchiv in Lissabon strebt der vorliegende Band eine kritische und analytische Untersuchung dieses Aspekts des transatlantischen Sklavenhandels an, der über so viele Jahre von den westlichen Historikern und Gelehrten verschleiert wurde. For over 400 years Black African men, women and children suffered the worst type of enslavement and humiliation from the hands of Catholics and other Western Christians during the transatlantic slave trade. Before now, no one could ever believe that the Popes of the Church were deeply involved in this Holocaust against Black African people. Despite the claims made by the hallowed papal office in Rome in recent years that the Popes condemned the enslavement of peoples wherever it existed, including that of Black Africans, recent researches in these fields of study have proved the contrary to be true. The Church and her Popes were rather among the major role players in this worst crime against Black Africans in

recorded history With the help of a considerable number of papal Bulls from the Vatican Secret Archives and a great amount of Royal documents from the Portuguese National Archives in Lisbon the present book is aiming to undertake a critical and analytical inquiry of this aspect of the transatlantic slavery that has been kept in the dark for so many years by the Western historians and scholars The results of this studious but fruitful academic inquiry are laid bare in this notable work of the 21st century Pius Onyemechi Adiele is a Catholic priest of Ahiara Diocese Mbaise and an alumnus of Seat of Wisdom Seminary Owerri and Bigard Memorial Seminary Enugu in Nigeria He obtained his licentiate in Theology from the famous University of Münster and his doctoral degree in Church History from the renowned University of Tübingen in Germany At present he is a research fellow in the areas of African Church History and Enslavement of peoples as well as the pastor in charge of the merged parishes of Lauchheim Westhausen Lippach Röttingen and Hülen in Germany

Based on the example of the Jesuits who taught at Rome's Jesuit University Collegio Romano between 1550 and 1650, this volume looks at the ways in which Catholic theologians thematised and interpreted slavery. The examination of the theological history is not restricted to the justification of slavery in the debates about natural law, but for the first time is expanded to take account of the various contemporary theological disciplines: biblical exegesis, scholastic theology, moral theology and casuistry. A chapter devoted to the Jesuit missions sheds light on actual encounters with slavery: Jesuits themselves could be slaves or slave owners. Thus the possibilities and boundaries of the Christian ethics of humanisation are explored.
