



WHY YOUR NOSE RUNS

When an organism invades, the body has an inflammatory response it starts. producing more muous (containing antibodies) for a thicker layer of protection (that's why your head, throat and chest are congested). Philegm is aust a mass of mucus mixed with dead. white blood cells. Clear or slightly yellow philogm usually means the invaders have not penetrated deeply. But green or brown philegm means more dead white cells, indicating that the organisms may have caused more damage. See a doctor.
