Campbell, 2011-07-25 During World War II the U S military lost some 35 000 aircraft to enemy action training incidents typhoons aircraft carrier deck mishaps mechanical failures or just normal wear and tear where aircraft were scrapped and used for parts to keep others flying Many just failed to return from their missions To date the 15 069 aircraft represented in this 3 volume set is information initially transferred from hand written Aircraft History Cards and are the total number of U S Navy Marine Corps and Coast Guard aircraft lost between 7 December 1941 and 15 August 1945 and lost outside the continental United States CONUS Volume III represents the total number of aircraft lost by their 176 different types and variants and represents the entire database to date Given the thousands of hours that went into this effort the author hopes that as a 3 volume set of reference books it provides assistance to others who are researching ship squadron and aircraft histories *The Fleet Air Arm in the Second World War, Volume II, 1942-1943* Ben Jones, 2018-06-13 This is the second of three volumes covering the transformation of the Fleet Air Arm during the Second World War As the subtitle of this volume *The Fleet Air Arm in Transition* suggests the years 1942 1943 marked a stepping stone between the small pre war cadre operating from a small number of carriers to a naval air arm flying modern aircraft types from a large number of ships and as will be seen in Volume III capable of operating a number of Fleet Carriers in the Pacific Ocean for sustained periods Whereas the majority of Volume I dealt with operations this volume has a much more even balance covering planning and policy on the one hand and operations on the other This reflects the crucial nature of this period as the development and expansion of the Fleet Air Arm gathered pace whilst an increasingly diverse range of operations took place with those in the Mediterranean and the Atlantic reaching a climax The reader will gain a clear appreciation of the growing importance indeed primacy of the aircraft carrier within the proposals for the future

composition of Royal Navy's surface fleet together with the nature of the Fleet Air Arm's expansion programmes. Such expansion programmes were hindered by the constraints of aircraft production and the acquisition of sufficient shore facilities for the formation of new squadrons and the continued support of others. Some of the Fleet Air Arm's most famous operations occurred during these years such as the escort of the Pedestal convoy to Malta, air cover for the landings in North Africa, Sicily and at Salerno, and the gallant but ill-fated attack of 825 Squadron during the Channel Dash. The increasing role played by the Fleet Air Arm aircraft operating from Escort Carriers and Merchant Aircraft Carriers in the Battle of the Atlantic during 1943 is also apparent. The documents in this volume will bring to life the difficulties of operating aircraft at sea, the nature of air combat and the complexities involved in expanding an organisation such as the Fleet Air Arm under wartime conditions. As such, it will enhance our understanding of the history of the Royal Navy's air arm during the Second World War.

Aces High, Volume 1 Christopher Shores, Clive Williams, 2008-09-18. First in the Aces High series, a military reference of the fighter pilots who had five or more confirmed victories while serving in the Royal Air Force. Introduced by the French quite early in World War I, the term ace was used to describe a pilot credited with five or more aerial victories. But in the United Kingdom, the term was never officially recognized. Becoming an ace was partly luck, especially considering the campaigns in which they flew and the areas of combat. There are three distinct kinds of aces: the defensive ace, the offensive ace, and the night fighter. This book is a revised collection of the biographies of the highest scoring Allied fighter pilots of World War II, including those with the confirmed claims of shooting down five aircraft and those pilots with lower scores but whose wartime careers prove them worthy of inclusion. All details of their combat are arranged in tabular form. Included are a selection of photographs from hitherto private collections. There are some authors whose name alone is sufficient reason to buy a book, and Christopher Shores is surely one of these. By profession a chartered surveyor, he served in the Royal Air Force in the 1950s, so his writing bears the stamp of authenticity.

Nielson, Ph.D., 2018-03-01 The most significant military development to touch Alaska during the interwar years was the advent of air power an innovation that completely altered Alaska s strategic position Suddenly the world became smaller as areas once thought safely distant from potential enemies became vulnerable Nowhere was this more evident than in the Pacific whose countless islands became potential advanced air bases As air technology improved the ability of long range bombers and by the 1930s of carrier aircraft to penetrate American airspace was a development of far reaching significance While such warnings were largely limited to a handful of air power advocates their vocal advocacy constituted nothing less than an insurrection a revolution in military thinking fought against entrenched military conservatism cultural aversion to change fears of budget cuts and War Department lethargy Indeed it was the air power crusader General Billy Mitchell who aggressively fought to convince the War and Navy Departments to embrace the new doctrine of offensive air power Mitchell came to understand Alaska s strategic importance early on Consequently he saw the Aleutians as a vulnerability if left unguarded Japan could creep up and by establishing air dominance take Alaska and Canada s West Coast But he also saw Alaska as a strategic base from which American planes could reduce Tokyo to powder Prophetically in 1923 Mitchell forecast precisely the military threat and strategic arguments that would shape military thinking almost twenty years later I am thinking of Alaska In an air war if we were unprepared Japan could take it away from us first by dominating the sky and creeping up the Aleutians By the mid to late 1930s military and civilian advocates of air power and more visionary strategists were beginning to make their voices heard in Congress and elsewhere decrying Alaska s military vulnerability Between 1933 and 1944 no one was more adamant than Alaska s Delegate in Congress Anthony Joseph Tony Dimond who challenged the nation to defend itself by defending Alaska To Dimond it seemed poor strategy to fortify one pacific base Hawaii while ignoring another Alaska Dimond s campaign was strengthened by passage of the Wilcox Bill sponsored by Representative J Mark Wilcox D Florida officially known as the National Air Defense Act This truly significant legislation authorized the location and construction of military airfields throughout the United States as a general defense preparedness measure Alaska was recognized as one of the nation s six strategic regions and two bases one at Anchorage the other at Fairbanks were recommended in part because Alaska was closer to Japan than it is to the center of the continental United States

Fortuitously for Alaska defense advocates General Douglas MacArthur stepped down as Chief of Staff of the Army and was replaced by Major General Malin Craig in October 1935 Craig and Brigadier General Stanley D Embick advocated a substantial reconfiguration of Plan Orange arguing that the Philippines presented an invitation to attack and should be neutralized in favor defending the Alaska Hawaii Panama Triangle Both the Army and Navy were charged with defending Alaska as far west as Dutch Harbor and the army pledged to mobilize 6 600 troops in Alaska within a month of attack by Japan In contemplating the defense of Alaska the Army General Staff formulated five priority objectives first increase the Alaska garrison second establish a major base for Army operations near Anchorage third develop a network of air bases within Alaska fourth garrison these bases with combat troops and fifth protect the naval installations at Sitka Kodiak and Dutch Harbor Alaska was about to go to war *Grumman F6F Hellcat* ,1998 **Fortitudine** ,1983 *Military Effectiveness: Volume 3, The Second World War* Allan R.
