Reflection of feelings

Eg. If a client expresses sadness, respond with, "It seems you're feeling quite down about this situation."



Paraphrasing

Eg. If a client says, "I'm overwhelmed with work," you might respond, "You feel swamped by your job responsibilities."



Summarising

Eg. Conclude a session with, "Today, we've discussed your challenges at work and your feelings of overwhelm."



Non-verbal communication

Eg. Maintain appropriate eye contact, nod in understanding, and adopt an open posture during sessions.
