Examining the recent saga of the Eli n Gonz lez custody battle, he shows how the cultural construction of *la lucha* has become a distinctly Miami style spirituality that makes *el exilio* the basis for religious reflection, understanding, and practice, and that conflates political mobilization with spiritual meaning in an ongoing confrontation with evil.
