INTRODUCTION

In sexually reproducing organisms, genetic information is passed from parents to offspring by means of haploid gametes (eggs and sperm) which unite to form a diploid zygote. The zygote receives half of its chromosomes from its father and from its mother. The genotype of the offspring is determined by the type of alleles the parents pass on them, in turn, the alleles present in the offspring will influence the observable traits in the new individuals, given rise to their specific phenotypes.
