Knott, 2022-10-01 Stephen F Knott has spent his life grappling with the legacy of President John F Kennedy JFK was the first president Knott remembers he worked for Ted Kennedy's Senate campaign in 1976 and later he worked at the John F Kennedy Library in Boston Moreover Knott's scholarly work on the American presidency has wrestled with Kennedy's time in office and whether his presidency was ultimately a positive or negative one for the country After initially being a strong Kennedy fan Knott's views began to sour during his time at the Library eventually leading him to become a Reagan Democrat The Trump presidency led Knott to revisit JFK leading him once more to reconsider his views *Coming to Terms with John F Kennedy* offers a nuanced assessment of the thirty fifth president whose legacy and impact people continue to debate to this day Knott examines Kennedy through the lens of five critical issues his interpretation of presidential power his approach to civil rights and his foreign policy toward Cuba the Soviet Union and Vietnam Knott also explores JFK's assassination and the evolving

interpretations of his presidency both highly politicized subject matters What emerges is a president as complex as the author's shifting views about him The passage of sixty years from working in the Kennedy Library to a career writing about the American presidency has given Knott a broader view of Kennedy's presidency and allowed him to see how both the Left and the Right and members of the Kennedy family distorted JFK's record for their own purposes Despite the existence of over forty thousand books dealing with the man and his era Coming to Terms with John F Kennedy offers something new to say about this brief but important presidency Knott contends that Kennedy's presidency for better or for worse mattered deeply and that whatever his personal flaws Kennedy's lofty rhetoric appealed to what is best in America without invoking the snarling nativism of his least illustrious successor Donald Trump

The US and Latin America Bevan Sewell, 2015-12-21 The US in the 1950s and 1960s wanted to prevent a new communist regime in the Western hemisphere at any cost Under President Eisenhower the US pursued a policy of support for dictators the economic shoring up of regimes that impoverished their own people and sanctioned direct interventions such as the overthrow of the Guatemalan government in 1954 When John F Kennedy came to power he promised a reset of relations and set about pouring aid into Latin America Yet in 1961 Kennedy also attempted to intervene in Central American domestic politics with the Bay of Pigs operation How far was each of the approaches pursued by the two administrations responsible for increasing tensions and encouraging radicalism on the continent In answering this question Bevan Sewell shows how Eisenhower's strategic stance on the Cold War became increasingly detrimental to Latin America over time and shows how similar policies were continued by the Kennedy administration The US and Latin America provides a new lens through which to assess US policy towards Latin America at an important time in inter American relations

Non-Aligned Movement Summits Jovan Cavoški, 2022-05-19 Using newly declassified documents from Serbian British Indian Chinese Myanmar U S and Soviet archives Non Aligned Movement Summits shows how the Non Aligned Movement NAM gradually evolved into the third force of Cold War politics enveloping most of the post colonial and non bloc world Jovan Cavo ki follows the evolution of the NAM through its summits and other gatherings during which major political decisions pertaining to the destiny of the Third World were made These events were scrutinized by all major powers and had a corresponding effect on their policies From the Belgrade Conference in 1961 until 1989 all major Third World and non bloc nations met to demonstrate to the Eastern and Western Blocs that they were independent active and respected participants in world affairs Cavo ki shows how these summits were also closely related to events occurring in the relationship between the two blocs providing opportunities for non bloc actors to influence the global balance of power By moving the focus of 20th century international history away from the bloc nations and instead giving developing nations in Africa and Asia due attention this book provides a fresh perspective on Cold War history and fills a significant gap in the literature It is an important study for all students and scholars of the Cold War and international history

The Ideological Scramble for Africa Frank Gerits, 2023-03-15 In The Ideological Scramble for Africa Frank Gerits

examines how African leaders in the 1950s and 1960s crafted an anticolonial modernization project Rather than choose Cold War sides between East and West anticolonial nationalists worked to reverse the psychological and cultural destruction of colonialism Kwame Nkrumah's African Union was envisioned as a federation of liberation to challenge the extant imperial forces the US empire of liberty the Soviet empire of equality and the European empires of exploitation In the 1950s the goal of proving the potency of a pan African ideology shaped the agenda of the Bandung Conference and Ghana's support for African liberation while also determining what was at stake in the Congo crisis and in the fight against white minority rule in southern and eastern Africa In the 1960s the attempt to remake African psychology was abandoned and socioeconomic development came into focus Anticolonial nationalists did not simply resist or utilize imperial and Cold War pressures but drew strength from the example of the Haitian Revolution of 1791 in which Toussaint Louverture demanded the universal application of Europe's Enlightenment values The liberationists of the postwar period wanted to redesign society in the image of the revolution that had created them The Ideological Scramble for Africa demonstrates that the Cold War struggle between capitalism and Communism was only one of two ideological struggles that picked up speed after 1945 the battle between liberation and imperialism proved to be more enduring The Non-Aligned Movement: Genesis, Organization and Politics (1927-1992) Jürgen Dinkel, 2018-11-26 The Non Aligned Movement had an important impact on the history of decolonization South South cooperation the Global Cold War and the North South conflict During the 20th century nearly all Asian African and Latin American countries joined the movement to make their voice heard in global politics In The Non Aligned Movement Jürgen Dinkel examines for the first time the history of the NAM since the interwar period as a special reaction of the Global South to changing global orders The study shows breaks and caesurae as well as continuities in the history of globalization and analyses the history of international relations from a non western perspective For this book empirical research was undertaken in Germany Great Britain Indonesia Russia Serbia and the United States Hearts, Minds, Voices Jason C.
