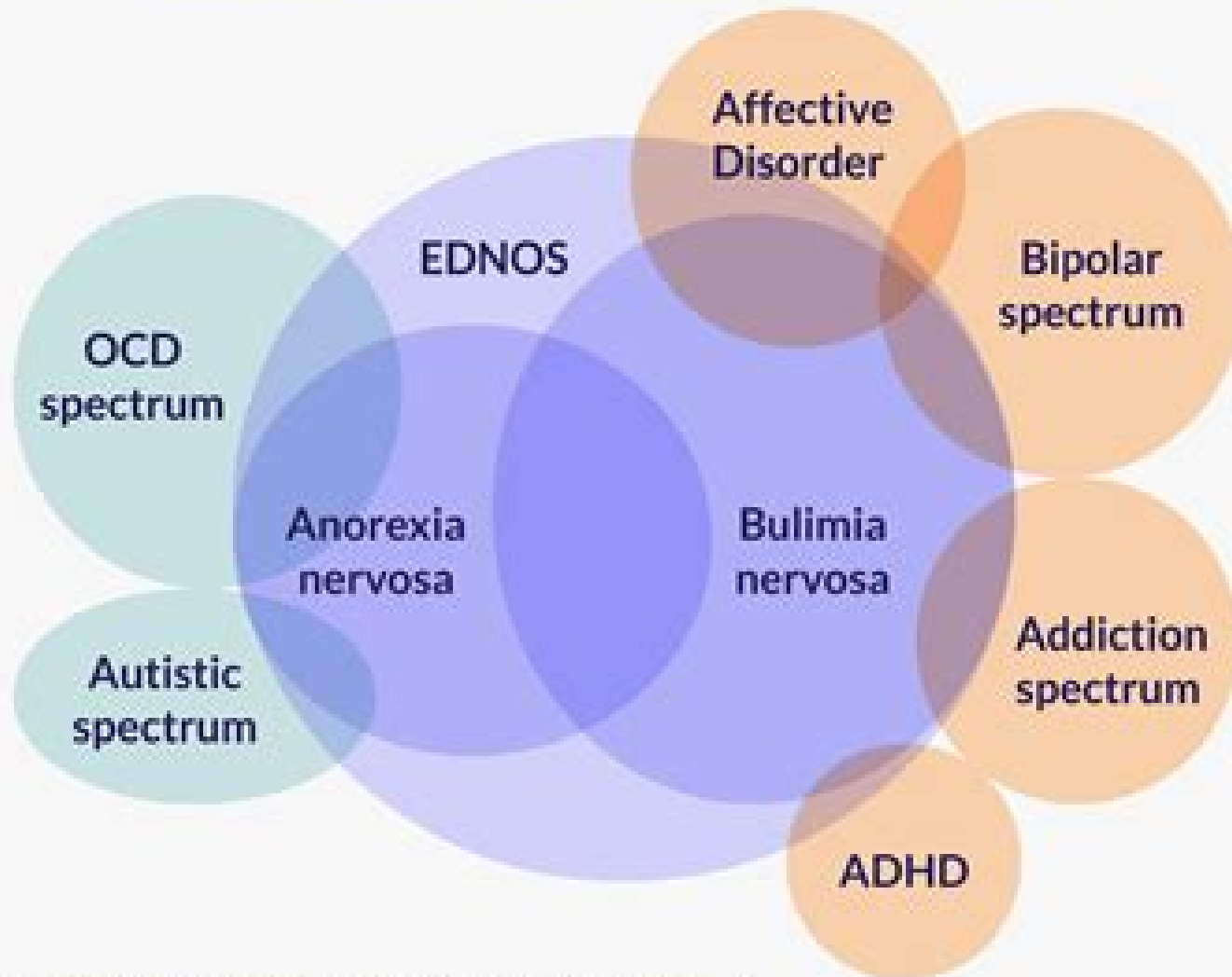

EDs can lead to high rates of morbidity and mortality, especially if they are misdiagnosed and untreated.
