Excerpt from *Makers of American History: A Beginner's Book in the History of Our Country*. This little book is an effort to sketch the lives of some of the makers of American history in such a way as to present the strong points of their characters and at the same time to narrate the main events in our history. It is believed that the book has a place in the schools in that it may be used in at least three different ways: as a primary history, as a supplement to a more formal school history, and as a supplementary reader.

1. As a primary history: It is universally conceded that the proper way to teach history to children is by means of biography, and for this purpose the book has been written. Children in the fourth, fifth, and sixth grades of school should be given elementary work in United States history, and in our belief this book is adapted to these grades. In order that it may serve as a primary history, geography and review questions have been added at the end of each chapter.
2. In connection with such books, this volume may easily be used, and thus the teacher can bring vividly before the pupil's mind the makers as well as the facts of our history.
