Maid to Order in Hong Kong Nicole Constable, 2007 In this update of her 1997 ethnography the author traces changes that have taken place in the service sector of Hong Kong's workforce since its reunification with mainland China in that year. Argues that though the influx of foreign domestic workers has risen dramatically and they are somewhat more politically active the abuse, lay offs and other challenges of these mostly Indonesian and Filipina women's daily lives in a globalized economy remain much the same as they relate in their own words.

Maid to Order in Hong Kong Nicole Constable, 1997 The forms of discipline range from physical abuse to intrusive regulations including restrictions on hair length and the prohibition of lipstick.

Maid to Order in Hong Kong Nicole Constable, 2017-12-15 Middle class Chinese women in the global city of Hong Kong have entered the workforce in unprecedented numbers over the past three decades and the demand for foreign domestic workers has soared. A decade ago some foretold the decline in foreign workers and the influx of mainland workers. But today over 120 000 women from the Philippines over 90 000 from Indonesia and thousands more from other parts of South and Southeast Asia serve as maids on two year contracts in Hong Kong sending much needed remittances to their families abroad. Nicole Constable tells their story by updating *Maid to Order in Hong Kong* with a focus on the major changes that have taken place since Hong Kong's reunification with mainland China in 1997, the Asian financial crisis of the late 1990s and the outbreak of SARS in 2002-2003. Interweaving her analysis with the women's individual stories she shows how power is expressed in the day to day lives of Filipina domestic workers and more recent Indonesian arrivals.

Migrant Workers in Asia Nicole Constable, 2013-09-13 This book provides rich and provocative comparative studies of South and Southeast Asian domestic workers who migrate to other parts of Asia. These studies range from Hong Kong, Macau and Singapore to Yemen, Israel, Jordan and the UAE. Conceptually and methodologically this book challenges us to move beyond established regional divides and proposes new ways of mapping inter Asian connections. The authors view migrant workers within a wider spatial context of intersecting groups and trajectories through time. Keenly attentive to the importance of migrants of diverse nationalities who have labored in multiple regions, this book examines intimate connections and distant divides in the social lives and politics of migrant workers across time and space. Collectively the authors propose new themes, new comparative frameworks and new methodologies for considering vastly different degrees of social support structures and political activism and the varied meanings of citizenship and state responsibility in sending and receiving countries. They highlight the importance of formal institutions that shape and promote migratory labor advocacy for workers or curtail workers' rights as well as the social identities and cultural practices and beliefs that may be linked to new inter ethnic social and political affiliations that traverse and also transform inter Asian spaces and pathways to mobility. This book was published as a special issue of *Critical Asian Studies*.

Maid to Queer Francisca Yuenki Lai, 2021-11-03 *Maid to Queer* is the first book about Asian female migrant workers who develop same sex relationships in a host city. Based on participant

observation and in depth interviews with Indonesian domestic workers in Hong Kong the book explores the meanings of same sex relationships to these migrant women Instead of searching for reasons to explain why they engage in a same sex relationship this book provides an ethnographic perspective by addressing their Sunday activities and considering how migration policies and the practices of Hong Kong people unintentionally produce alternative sexuality and desires for them The author contrasts the migrant experiences of same sex relationships with the Western discourse that individuals carry a strong sense of sexual identification prior to migration same sex desires among Indonesian domestic workers are often not realized until they leave home Addressing the changes from maid to queer this book documents the intersections of domestic work labor migration race and religion on the sexual subject formation specifically how Indonesian women negotiate heteronormativity and remake a space for their love sex and intimacy For those interested in lesbian studies Asian labor migration sexual citizenship and queer migration this ethnography fills an important gap in explaining how the feminization of international migration and the constraints imposed on live in domestic workers unintentionally become productive possibilities of queerness and normativity Maid to Queer combines insights from migration studies with those of LGBT studies contributing to both It examines the sexual subjectivities and shifting sexualities of these domestic workers in relation to both migrant labor policies and the anxieties and practices of their employers in Hong Kong Lai s book is very enticing to read Saskia Wieringa University of Amsterdam This is the first book I know of exploring sexuality among domestic workers Lai shows that sexuality is relative to both imagination and opportunity and that it can change over time Women may desire women or they may not context shapes this desire and how this desire plays out Sharyn Davies Monash University

Ladegaard, 2023-08-23 Drawing on a corpus of 113 narratives told by migrant workers who have returned to their home country Ladegaard details Indonesian and Filipina domestic migrant workers experiences of homecoming after years of work abroad separated from their loved ones The narratives deal with two major themes 1 Migrant workers experiences in the diaspora which for many particularly Indonesian workers were associated with abuse and exploitation leading to trauma and 2 migrant workers experiences of coming home which include both the happy reunion with the family but also concerns about not fitting in and the need to reinvent themselves because they are not who they were when they left This is particularly true for workers whose migratory journeys have failed and who have come back to their hometowns without any financial award Chapters also explore the major difference between Filipina and Indonesian migrant workers overseas experiences The Filipina returnees share mostly positive stories while the Indonesian returnees uncover mostly negative stories further illuminating what may explain these diverse migratory experiences Finally the book discusses how research on disenfranchised groups like domestic migrant workers can be used for social and political action An excellent text that will appeal to academics teachers and postgraduate students in the humanities and social sciences particularly in sociolinguistics applied linguistics intercultural communication anthropology
