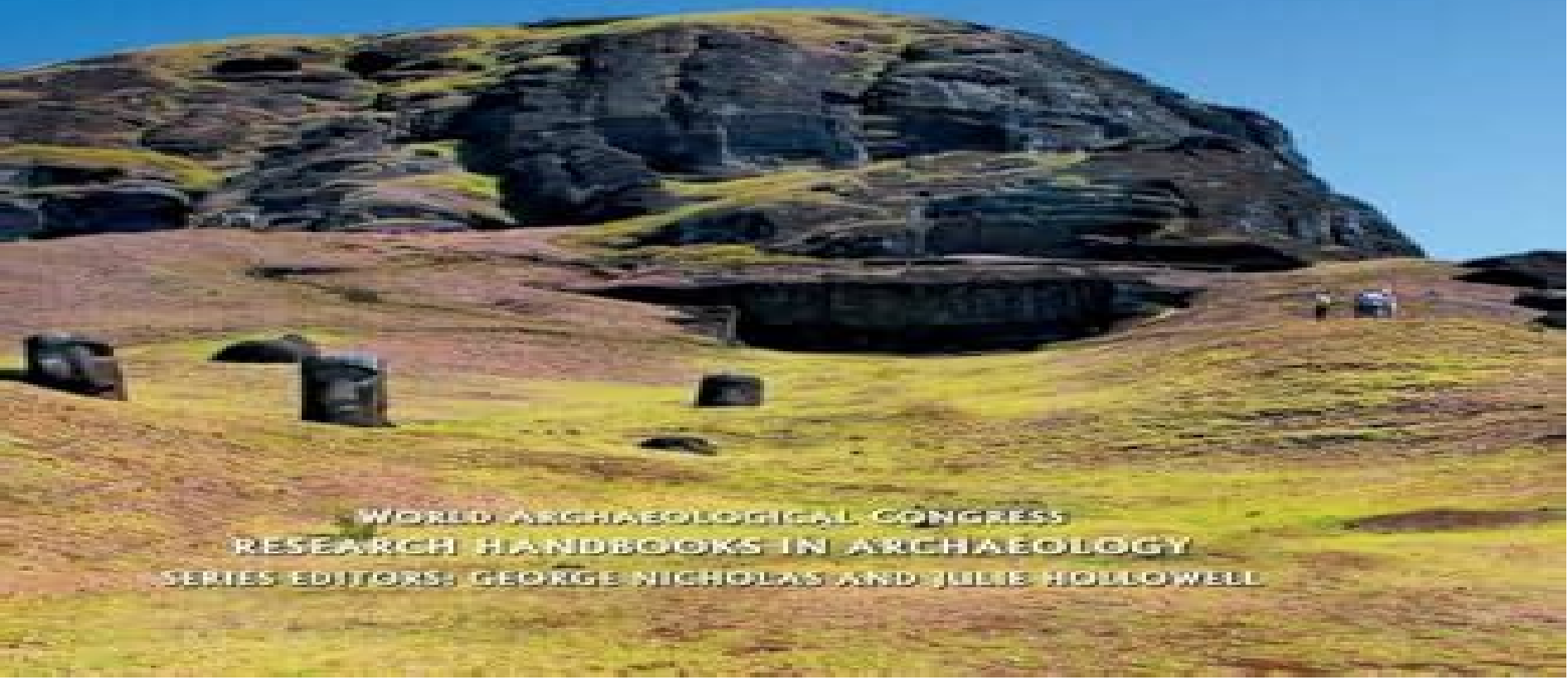

Polkowski, 2024-08-31 First fully illustrated presentation of a large but generally little known assemblage of petroglyphic rock art from the Western Desert of Egypt Rock art in Dakhleh was produced for perhaps as long as 10 millennia resulting in the formation of hundreds of sites displaying thousands of images In some places petroglyphs form a true melting pot of iconographic creations elsewhere only isolated depictions appear on rock surfaces Various rock art traditions from prehistoric through pharaonic Graeco Roman and mediaeval have all added to a tremendous variety of petroglyphs their formal traits and subject matter This book is the first ever monograph on Dakhleh Oasis rock art providing both an introduction to the versatile topic as well as an overview of the current state of research It is designed as a collection of essays that deal with specific aspects of the research The reader is offered here not only old and new documentation much of it previously unpublished but also a great deal of innovative interpretation All chapters although devoted to different case studies revolve around an all encompassing concept of landscape of motion It is argued here that rock art regardless of its date of origin was and is always involved in certain dynamic contexts In Dakhleh the majority of petroglyphs especially during historical periods were produced in spatial contexts of paths and routes and thus by people on the move It is argued here that various kinds of movement were often a significant factor contributing to the meaning and function of the images The intention of this book is to explore and unveil such contexts which may prove somewhat elusive if we focus our analyses exclusively on the representational aspects of rock art Such a type of integration of rock art landscape and motion is the major aim of this work and has hopefully been achieved by merging perspectives and concepts derived from Egyptology Anthropology and other social sciences

understood the place in which they lived and worked The impact of and narrative surrounding gold mining has meant that it has long been a focus of study both historical and archaeological The archaeology of mining has traditionally fallen under the umbrella of industrial archaeology with analyses based on historical economic and technological evidence However this is changing From an industrial focus examining the remnants of mines and associated processing equipment archaeology has progressed towards understandings of the social aspects of mining recognising that people not just equipment occupied these landscapes Nevertheless there remains a separation between industrial technology based studies and purely social household based archaeological studies a division that overlooks the integration of home and livelihood This work addresses these very challenges using a landscape based approach that articulates a nuanced meaning laden and experienced mining landscape Integrating the social and the industrial the case study of Mount Shamrock a gold mining town in Queensland Australia demonstrates how this methodology can enhance our understanding of the past The work presents an integration of social and industrial perspectives in a mining settlement and provides an exemplar in the application of landscape theory to Australian historical archaeology These concepts and approaches developed in an Australian context are of universal interest

Landscapes of Social Transformation in the Salinas Province and the Eastern Pueblo World Katherine A.

Spielmann, 2017-10-31 In the 1100s most Pueblo peoples lived in small dispersed settlements and moved frequently but by the mid 1400s they had aggregated into large villages The majority of these villages were still occupied at Spanish contact and conquest by which time most Pueblo peoples had completely transformed their perception and experience of village life Other changes were taking place on a broader regional scale and the migrations from the Colorado Plateau and the transformation of Chaco initiated myriad changes in ritual organization and practice Landscapes of Social Transformation in the Salinas Province and the Eastern Pueblo World investigates relationships between diverse regional and local changes in the Rio Grande and Salinas areas from 1100 to 1500 C E The contributing authors draw on the results of sixteen seasons of archaeological survey and excavation in the Salinas Province of central New Mexico The chapters offer cross scale analyses to compare broad perspectives in well researched southwestern culture changes to the finer details of stability and transformation in Salinas This stability which was unusual in the Pueblo Southwest from the 1100s until its abandonment in the 1670s provides an interesting contrast to migration based transformations studied elsewhere in the Rio Grande region

books focus on the gendered gaze of European men upon the landscape this collection emphasizes that native men and native women looked upon natural formations and constructed landscapes differently from one another a difference in perception that is important for archaeologists and anthropologists to understand While there have been advances toward admitting this more complex view in the rest of the world Native American Landscapes is the first to focus on how native men and women viewed the world around them Native American Landscapes is organized by region taking readers across the country from the rock shelters of the Cumberland Plateau in the east to the Mojave Desert and the Mexican Gulf Coast then north to what is now British Columbia and farther west to Hawaii Readers of this collection through a study of creation myths vision quests fertility shrines and other ritualized uses of landscape will learn more about the land and about humans perception of our natural surroundings which forms the bedrock of our present relationship with the natural world CHERYL CLAASSEN is professor of anthropology at Appalachian State University She is the author or editor of six books on Native American prehistory including Feasting with Shellfish in the Southern Ohio Valley Shells Rituals and Beliefs in Archaic North America and Women in Prehistory North America and Mesoamerica Pragmatics of Space Andreas H.
