

Today We're Alive Linden Wilkinson, 2016-04-26 By 1888 after 100 years of colonisation it is estimated that 95% of the Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait islander population had disappeared Along with starvation disease dispossession and grief a further contributing factor to this decline was murder Massacres occurred sequentially as the line of first contact forged its way across a country that had been occupied cared for and loved for over 50 000 years by about 250 separate Aboriginal nations The concomitant brutality subsumed in the colonial narrative of zeal purpose and prosperity meant that massacres were shrouded in silence for generations denied ignored and under reported However one particular massacre remains an anomaly The massacre at Myall Creek occurred on June 10th 1838 in the fading light of a wintry Sunday afternoon It was perpetrated by eleven convicts under the leadership of one free born squatter s son they had hunted blacks together before They tethered twenty eight old men women and children Weraerai people of the Kamilaroi nation led them away from their camp and then systematically butchered them all These details are available because this particular massacre went to trial One hundred and sixty two years later a group of Aboriginal and non Aboriginal people formed a
