sequences with corresponding patterns that recognize and interpret each segment of a text Memory produces meaning from these patterns In harmony with its goals memory may adopt specific strategies to deal with different stimuli Dynamic patterns link the unit of processing with the unit of meaning In sum Babuts proposes that meaning is achieved through metaphors and narrative and that both are ways to reach cognitive goals This original study offers perspectives that will interest cognitive psychologists as well as those simply interested in the process through which literature stirs the human Robert Graves and the Classical Tradition Alisdair G.
