The machine learning paradigms presented can be broadly divided into the following three categories supervised learning unsupervised learning and semi supervised learning Supervised learning algorithms focus on learning a mapping function and they are trained with supervision on labeled data Supervised learning is further sub divided into classification and regression algorithms Unsupervised learning typically does not have access to ground truth and often the goal is to learn or uncover the hidden pattern in the data Through semi supervised learning one can effectively utilize a large volume of unlabeled data and a limited amount of labeled data to improve machine learning model performances Deep learning and neural networks are also covered in this book Deep neural networks have attracted a lot of interest during the last ten years due to the availability of graphics processing units GPU

networks However these tasks require dealing with non Euclidean graph data that contains rich relational information between elements and cannot be well handled by traditional deep learning models e g convolutional neural networks CNNs or recurrent neural networks RNNs Nodes in graphs usually contain useful feature information that cannot be well addressed in most unsupervised representation learning methods e g network embedding methods Graph neural networks GNNs are proposed to combine the feature information and the graph structure to learn better representations on graphs via feature propagation and aggregation Due to its convincing performance and high interpretability GNN has recently become a widely applied graph analysis tool This book provides a comprehensive introduction to the basic concepts models and applications of graph neural networks It starts with the introduction of the vanilla GNN model Then several variants of the vanilla model are introduced such as graph convolutional networks graph recurrent networks graph attention networks graph residual networks and several general frameworks Variants for different graph types and advanced training methods are also included As for the applications of GNNs the book categorizes them into structural non structural and other scenarios and then it introduces several typical models on solving these tasks Finally the closing chapters provide GNN open resources and the outlook of several future directions Positive Unlabeled Learning Kristen Jaskie, Andreas Spanias, 2022-04-20 Machine learning and artificial intelligence AI are powerful tools that create predictive models extract information and help make complex decisions. Learning and Decision-Making from Rank Data Lirong Xia,2022-06-01 The ubiquitous challenge of learning and decision making from rank data arises in situations where intelligent systems collect preference and behavior data from humans learn from the data and then use the data to help humans make efficient effective and timely decisions Often such data are represented by rankings This book surveys some recent progress toward addressing the challenge from the
