Ana Castillo's *So Far from God* to Leslie Marmon Silko's *Gardens in the Dunes*. In international literature he analyzes Mo Yan's *The Garlic Ballads*, Jiang Rong's *Wolf Totem*, Michiko Ishimure's *The Lake of Heaven*, Miyuki Miyabe's *All She Was Worth* and other novels. The book concludes with a reading of Ernest Callenbach's *Ecotopia* and *Ecotopia Emerging* and an Afterword recommending further directions for transversal ecocritical research and an interview that discusses Murphy's previous book *Transversal Ecocritical Praxis* and provides some personal background on the author.
