University and a Ph D in English from the University of Pennsylvania She has published four books of poems *The Venus Hottentot* 1990 *Body of Life* 1996 *Antebellum Dream Book* 2001 and most recently *American Sublime* 2005 which was one of three finalists for the Pulitzer Prize Her play *Diva Studies* was produced at the Yale School of Drama She is presently Professor of American and African American Studies at Yale University
